WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **B.E.S. College of Education, VI Block, Jayanagar, Bangalore-560011, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.KAR/B.Ed./04/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/911 dt. 10.07.2000 for **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2000-2001.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Corrigendum vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS03408/B.Ed./KA/2016/83377 on 05.04.2016 was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students for one basic unit from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.02.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 09.03.2019.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 376th meeting held on 11th – 12th June 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.06.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 26.10.2020.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice. The institution has submitted its reply vide dated 26.10.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has not submitted Land Use Certificate.
2. The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of Building Plan in which multi-purpose hall area is not mentioned.
3. The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of BCC which is not approved by the competent authority.
4. The institution has not submitted a Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format.
5. The institution has not submitted a "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manager along with re-validated FDRs.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **B.E.S. College of Education, VI Block, Jayanagar, Bangalore-560011, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **B.E.S. College of Education, VI Block, Jayanagar, Bangalore-560011, Karnataka** run by **Bharath Education Society, 4th Block, Jayanagar, Bangalore, Karnataka-560011** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (1 basic unit)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
