WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Banjara Education College, Banjar Nagar Solapur Road, Bijapur, Karnataka-586103** run by **Bijapur Jilla Banjara Vidya Vardhak Sangh, Banjara Nargar Solapur Road, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRC/NCTE/2009/B.Ed./RO/14482 dt. 08.07.2009 for conducting **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2009-2010.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct, 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN in all such institutions. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 28.02.2020.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 04.11.2020 & 12.11.2020.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-*

*The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 04.11.2020 & 12.11.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.*

1. *The institution shown appointed 3 faculty after promulgation of NCTE Regulations dated 09.06.2017. The same is not having NET/Ph.D. as per*

NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017.

2. The institution did not appointed faculty for performing arts.
3. The institution has submitted English translated copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate in which property type mentions as Agriculture.
4. The institution has submitted Building Completion Certificate which is not in prescribed format of NCTE Regulations.
5. Site area and multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan. Seal is in regional language, hence issuing authority is not clear.
6. The institution did not submit Land Use Certificate in prescribed format of NCTE Regulations.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Banjara Education College, Banjar Nagar Solapur Road, Bijapur, Karnataka-586103 for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.**"

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Banjara Education College, Banjar Nagar Solapur Road, Bijapur, Karnataka-586103** run by **Bijapur Jilla Banjara Vidya Vardhak Sangh, Banjara Nargar Solapur Road, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

***"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."***

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
