WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Vishwa Bharathi College of Education, Morappur Post, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District – 635305, Tamil Nadu run by Vishwa Bharathi Educational Trust, Dharmapuri District, Tamil Nadu – 635305 on dt. 12.12.2007 for conducting M.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 25 students.

AND WHEREAS, the enhancement of intake from existing 25 to 35 was permitted vide NCTE's order dt. 25.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted an affidavit dt 12.01.2015 for adherence of new Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2015 for conducting two-years M.Ed course of 50 students for 2015-16 academic session.

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued on 26.03.2019 in compliance of 369th meeting. And a Final Show Cause Notice dt 27.11.2019 was issued in compliance of 380th meeting. The institution has not replied to both the notices.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 389th Virtual Meeting held from 12th & 14th October 2020 decided as under: -

"The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 27.11.2019.

1. The institution has failed in submission of written representation along with all required documents in response to Final Show Cause Notice.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Vishwa Bharathi College of Education, Morappur Post, harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District – 635305, Tamil Nadu for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Vishwa Bharathi College of Education, Morappur Post, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District – 635305, Tamil Nadu run by Vishwa Bharathi Educational Trust, Dharmapuri District, Tamil Nadu – 635305 for conducting M.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17 of 1993 of NCTE Regulations the institution namely Vishwa Bharathi College of Education, Morappur Post, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District – 635305, Tamil Nadu run by Vishwa Bharathi Educational Trust, Dharmapuri District, Tamil Nadu - 635305, is hereby withdrawn for conducting M.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students on the grounds mentioned above. The withdrawal of recognition is effective from the academic session commences next to issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or when an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
