WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **SMRK Mahila Vidya Vardhaka Sangha College of Education, Kallur Building, Rajput Galli, Indi Road, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka** run by **SMRK Mahila Vidya Vardhaka Sangha College of Education, Kallur Building, Rajput Galli, Indi Road, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2004-2005/8830 dt. 30.11.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 21.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 315th meeting held during 17th & 18th June 2016 has considered the written representation of the institution dated 31.10.2015 and has decided to issue an inspection letter to the institution. As per the decision of SRC, a letter to the institution was sent on 12.07.2016. Accordingly, VT members names were generated through online VT module for inspection during the period 26.09.2016 to 16.10.2016. Inspection of the institution was conducted on 05.10.2016 and the VT report along with documents received on 08.10.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 344th meeting held during 17th – 18th August, 2017 considered the VT report and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. As per the decision of SRC, the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.09.2017. The SRC in its 362nd meeting held on 21st & 22nd August 2018 has considered the written representation submitted by the institution on 02.01.2017 & 11.01.2018 and has decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 29.08.2018. The institution vide letter dated 15.05.2020 submitted its reply on 25.06.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th-15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 23.09.2020. The institution vide letter dated 29.10.2020 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 5th-6th January 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 29.10.2020 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

- 1. The institution has submitted photocopy of R.T.C. and Sale Deed. However, the institution has not submitted certified copy of land document. The land document submitted is in the name of an individual which not permissible under NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- 2. The survey no. mentioned in the building plan is 523/2A but the survey no. mentioned in the land document is 253/2A, 253/3A. The Multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan.*
- 3. The survey no. mentioned in BCC is 253/2A but the survey no. mentioned in the land document is 253/2A, 253/3A. The BCC submitted by the institution is not in the format prescribed by the NCTE.*
- 4. The institution has not submitted Form 'A' issued by the Branch Manager. The FDRs submitted by the institution has been expired.*
- 5. The Built-up area is not readable in the building plan. Multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan.*
- 6. Date of joining in the faculty list is not mentioned for "Prof. Guruballappa J. Hattalli, Prof. Bandenawaz H. Awati, Prof. Priya Shetti, Prof. Mahadev Shinde, Dr. Vijayalaxmi Ningappa Kenganal, Prof. Sharadabai D Manami, Prof. Jnyneshwari B Shirahattimath Prof. Muttappa N Kokatnur, Prof. Sadashic A. Huggi and Prof. Anand Honwad".*
- 7. Faculty list submitted by the institution is not approved by the affiliating body.*
- 8. 3 Lecturers have been shown appointed before promulgation of NCTE Regulations dated 09.06.2017, thus not having NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.*
- 9. As per order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2004-2005/8830 dated 30.11.2004 the institution shall shift to its own premises/building within three years from the date of recognition. However as per VT report, the institution is not functioning from its own building. And the institution has not clarify the same.*

*Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to **SMRK Mahila Vidya Vardhaka Sangha College of Education, Kallur Building, Rajput Galli, Indi Road, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."*

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **SMRK Mahila Vidya Vardhaka Sangha College of Education, Kallur Building, Rajput Galli, Indi Road, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka** run by **SMRK Mahila Vidya Vardhaka Sangha College of Education, Kallur Building, Rajput Galli, Indi Road, Bijapur-586101, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
