WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to **Jai Jyothi College of Physical Education, Opp. Old. Hero Honda ShowRoom, B.V.B. College Road, Tirupathi Tirumala Plaza, Bidar – 585403, Karnataka** for **B.P.Ed.** course vide order no.:F.SRO/NCTE/NCTE/2005-2006/5081 dated 03.01.2006 for conducting (B.P.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) students.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 affidavit submitted on dt. 14.07.2015 by the institution, the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on dt. 16.07.2015 for conducting **B.P.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two sections of 50 students each)** from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notices dt. 28.06.2019 was issued for submission of certain documents as decided to the SRC in its 376th Meeting of SRC held on 11th – 12th June 2019. The institution has not submitted any reply in respect to the show cause notice issued on 28.06.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter of the such institution were placed before the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September 2020. The Committee decided that a Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the such institutions which have not submitted any representation to the Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.10.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has not submitted any representation in response to both the Show Cause notices.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 5th – 6th January, 2021 considered and decided as the following grounds:

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

- 1. The institution has not responded to the Final Show Cause Notice issued on 13.10.2020.**

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Jai Jyothi College of Physical Education, Opp. Old. Hero Honda ShowRoom, B.V.B. College Road, Tirupathi Tirumala Plaza, Bidar – 585403, Karnataka for conducting B.P.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."**

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Jai Jyothi College of Physical Education, Opp. Old. Hero Honda ShowRoom, B.V.B. College Road, Tirupathi Tirumala Plaza, Bidar – 585403, Karnataka for B.P.Ed. course vide order no.:F.SRO/NCTE/NCTE/2005-2006/5081 dated 03.01.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.


Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
