WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS The institution **ST. John's College of Education for Women, Post Box No.201, Dhanusha Complex, New Shankarapalyam Road, Tole Gate, Vellore-632001, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/5124 dated 06.01.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 11.02.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 05.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 14.03.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with documents dt.09.04.2019 in respect of Show Cause Notice issued above.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th - 19th September 2019 wherein the committee decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice.** Accordingly, as per the committee decision a final show cause notice was issued to the institute vide letter dt.03.10.2019

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its reply dt. 19.02.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 393rd Meeting held on 05th & 06th January 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 19.02.2020 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

1. **The land is in favour of A. Vijaya Kumar Rajasekar i.e., an individual which is not permissible as per clause 8 (4) (i) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.**
2. **Other documents related to land such as building plan, NEC, CLU, BCC etc., can not be accepted on the face of deficiency in land documents.**
3. **As per Building Plan the size of M.P. HALL IS 197 sq. mts (2120 sq. ft.) whereas the BCC shows the size as 2484 sq. ft. The institute submitted ambiguous documents.**
4. **The Building Plan submitted by the institute is not approved by the Competent Authority.**
5. **Faculty is not approved by the affiliating body.**
6. **Only 3 Assistant Professors have been appointed for perspective of Education against the requirement of 4.**
7. **Only 15 Faculty has been shown by the institute against the requirement of 16 under NCTE Regulations, 2014."**


NOW THEREFORE, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **ST. John's College of Education for Women, Post Box No.201, Dhanusha Complex, New Shankarapalyam Road, Tole Gate, Vellore-632001, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
