WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Prathibha College of Education, Ibrahimpatnam, Sagar Road, Rangareddy, Andhra Pradesh-501506** run by **Prathibha Educational Society, Rangareddy District, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2007-2008/11231 dt. 10.09.2007 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 294th Meeting held on 14th to 16th November, 2015 considered the matter of the institution who have not submitted affidavit adhering to Regulations 2014 and decided to issue Show Cause Notice.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016. The institution did not submit any reply to Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410th Meeting held on 25th & 26th April, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. *The institution was issued a Show Cause Notice dt. 20.05.2016 to submit the explanation for non-submission of Affidavit affirming adherence of provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014 which resulted into non-issuance of Provisional Revised Recognition Order for conducting two years' B.Ed. course.*
2. *The institution failed in submission of reply to the Show Cause Notice dt. 20.05.2016.*

*Hence the recognition granted to **Prathibha College of Education, Ibrahimpatnam, Sagar Road, Rangareddy, Andhra Pradesh -501506** for **B.Ed. course** is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e., **2022-2023**. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counselling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e., **2022-2023**."*

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Prathibha College of Education, Ibrahimpatnam, Sagar Road, Rangareddy, Andhra Pradesh - 501506** for conducting **B.Ed. programme of 100 students** with effect from the academic session i.e., **2022-2023** onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from

the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate counselling from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session 2022-2023.

6. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
