WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 of NCTE Act. 1993 was granted to the institution namely Jairam College of Education, Salem By-Pass Road NH-7, Near Mahamariamman Temple, Karur, Tamilnadu-639002 run by Jairams Educational Trust, Karur District, Tamilnadu vide SRC (NCTE) order F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/13066 dated 16.10.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had submitted affidavit dated 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.08.2021. The institution did not submit reply to the Show Cause Notice.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 406th Meeting held on 17th & 18th January, 2022 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.02.2022. The institution has submitted reply on 04.04.2022.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 410^{th} Meeting held on 25^{th} 26^{th} April 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 04.04.2022. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The building plan submitted by the institution is not approved by the competent authority.

2. The following faculty was appointed after notification (dt. 09.06.2017) of NCTE (Amendment) Regulations, 2014 and are not qualified as not possessing NET qualification, hence, not eligible to be applyinted:

- The institution did not submit details of administrative and professional staff as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 for B.Ed. course.
- 4. The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 5. The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 6. The institution did not submit registration certificate and bye laws of the managing society / trust.

Hence the recognition granted to Jairam College of Education, Salem By-Pass Road NH-7, Near Mahamariamman Temple, Karur, Tamilnadu-639002 for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counseling / making admissions from the academic session i.e. 2022-2023."

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Jairam College of Education, Salem By-Pass Road NH-7, Near Mahamariamman Temple, Karur, Tamilnadu-639002 run by Jairams Educational Trust, Karur District, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) for B.Ed. course with effect from the academic session i.e. 2022-2033 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate counselling from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session 2022-2023.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
