#### WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, Notre Dame Junior College of Education, No. 70, Palace Road, C/o. Sophia High School, Bangalore, Karanataka-560001 run by The Barat Society, Bangalore, Karnataka for D.Ed. & D.Ed-Al programme as per following details:-

- (i) The SRC vide order no. F. No. F.ELE/Com/01/SRO/NCTE/2001-2002/9846 dt. 25.02.2002 for conducting Elementary course of two years duration from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 40 students.
- (ii) The SRC vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/D.Ed.-Al/2004-2005/5239 dated 30.01.2006 for conducting Elementary (D.Ed) course of two and half years duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 50 students which includes the existing intake of 40 and an additional intake of 10.
- 2. AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 23.11.2021 requested for closure of the D.Ed & D.Ed.-Al Programme. The SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 considered the request for closure of the D.Ed. & D.Ed.-Al Programme matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the institution vide email dated 23.11.2021 by withdrawing the recognition granted to Notre Dame Junior College of Education, No. 70, Palace Road, C/o. Sophia High School, Bangalore, Karanataka-560001 for conducting D.Ed. & D.El.Ed-Al Programme under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2021-2022.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director as per the general resolution taken by the SRC in this meeting."

3. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Notre Dame Junior College of Education, No. 70, Palace Road, C/o. Sophia High School, Bangalore, Karanataka-560001 run by The Barat Society, Bangalore, Karnataka for conducting D.Ed. & D.Ed.-Al Programme of two and half years duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 50 students which includes the existing intake of 40 and an additional intake of 10 with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards.

**4.** Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

**5.** Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
