WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Ganesh Nagar, Kumbharwada Road, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** run by **Vishal Education Society, Bidar District, Karnataka** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/15693 dt. 06.12.2007 for conducting secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 04.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution vide letter dated 29.06.2015 requested for 2 units to 1 unit. A corrigendum was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS05783/B.Ed./KA/2015/70373 dt. 21.07.2015 for grants recognition to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22nd Oct., 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.10.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 11.02.2020 & 10.03.2021.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 401st Meeting held on 11th & 12th August 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.08.2021. The institution did not submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th Meeting held on 13th & 14th December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice on 31.08.2021. The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Ganesh Nagar, Kumbarwada Road, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Rajiv Gandhi College of Education, Ganesh Nagar, Kumbarwada Road, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** run by **Vishal Education Society, Bidar District, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (1 basic unit)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
