**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Ayira Vaisya College of Education, No. 5/338, Sowkathali Street, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, Tamilnadu-623707** run by **Ayira Vaisya Sabai, Ramanathapuram District, Tamilnadu-623707** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2008/6150 dt. 21.10.2008 for **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students for two basic units** from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 369<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT Repost accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.09.2019. The institution has submitted reply on 14.10.2019.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 401<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.08.2021. The institution did not submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

*The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice on 31.08.2021. The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN).*

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Ayira Vaisya College of Education, No. 5/338, Sowkathali Street, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, Tamilnadu-623707** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."*

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Ayira Vaisya**

**College of Education, No. 5/338, Sowkathali Street, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, Tamilnadu-623707** run by **Ayira Vaisya Sabai, Ramanathapuram District, Tamilnadu-623707** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

***"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."***

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
