WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely **Century Foundation College of Education, S.No.628/2C1B, 629/2B1, 2B3, 1B, Rackiyapalayam, Vijayapuram Post, Nallur – Tirupur 641606, Coimbatore** was granted recognition vide letter no.:F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/13913 dated 01.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 20.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 21.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of decision taken by the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt.20.12.2019 (P-528/Coors.) with the direction to submit compliance of RPRO. The institution has submitted its written representation on 07.01.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February, 2020, wherein the Committee considered the matter and decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act.** Accordingly, as per the decision a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt.05.03.2020. The institution has submitted its reply along with relevant documents on 12.03.2020.

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AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 5th – 6th January, 2021 considered and decided as the following grounds:

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 12.03.2020 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

- i. In respect of previous remarks on the Sale Deed the institute submitted that it was submitted due to clerical error now they had submitted two Lease Deeds dt 27.12.2005 in the name of the College.
- ii. Vide letter dt 12.03.2020 the institute requesting for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit and it had submitted staff list as 1+7 against the requirement of 1+9 for 1 basic unit of B.Ed. The institution has also not appointed faculty for Fine Arts, Performing Arts.
- iii. The faculty namely Mrs. D. Umamaheshwari is not qualified as not possessing NET and the joining date is 22.09.2017. Since the NET qualification is mandatory as amended in NCTE Regulations, 2014 vide its notification dt. 09.06.2017.
- iv. It is not clear that advertisement for requirement was given in newspaper on 11.03.2020 and the date was given in newspaper on 11.03.2020 and the date of joining shown much before that.
- v. It is also not understandable that the approval of the faculty given by TNTEU vide letter dt 09.08.2017 and 31.10.2017 after notification dt 09.06.2017 and the faculty is not possessing NET qualification.
- vi. The Building Plan submitted by the institution shows that the area of Multipurpose Hall as 139.29 sq.mtr (1499.30 sq.ft) which is not adequate as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Century Foundation College of Education, No. 628/2C, 629/2, B-1, Rackiyapalayam, Vijayapuram Post, Nallur – Tirupur 641606, Coimbatore** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of Century Foundation College of Education, S.No.628/2C1B, 629/2B1, 2B3, 1B, Rackiyapalayam, Vijayapuram Post, Nallur – Tirupur 641606, Coimbatore was granted recognition vide letter no.:F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/13913 dated 01.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.**

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Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
