**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the institution Deccan M.Ed. College, Noorani Moholla, Near Peer Bangali Dargah, Ring Road, Gulbarga, Karnataka-585104 was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/M.Ed./2006-2007/8026 of dt. 14.08.2007 for conducting M.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 25 students.

**AND WHEREAS**, the consequent upon the notification of the National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Regulation, 2010 on dt. 20.08.2010 the intake of existing 25 students in M.Ed. course was increased from 25 to 35 vide SRC, NCTE order dt. 30.07.2010.

**AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 16.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

**AND WHEREAS**, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 20.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

**AND WHEREAS**, a Show Cause Notices dt. 30.04.2019 followed by Final Show Cause Notice 15.10.2019 was issued for submission of certain documents as decided by the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> Meeting & 380<sup>th</sup> meeting for M.Ed. programme respectively.

**AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted its representations on dt. 07.01.2020 & 10.12.2019.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 393<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> & 06<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 07.01.2020 & 10.12.2019 in respect to the Final Show Cause Notice and found the following deficiencies: -

1. **The institution has submitted photocopy of SALE deed. The institution has not submitted certified copy of Registered land.**
2. **The institution has submitted an approval letter dt 05.11.2015 signed by the Registrar of Gulbarga University. But, the institution has not submitted proforma of the staff in prescribed format as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 for both B.Ed and M.Ed courses.**
3. **The institution has submitted Land Use Certificate wherein the Survey No. is mentioned as 35/2A, but in the Sale Deed there is no such survey no. was mentioned.**
4. **The institution has not submitted notarized English version of latest encumbrance Certificate duly signed by the concerned competent authority.**
5. **The Building Plan & Site Plan submitted by the institution is not legible nor approved by the competent authority.**
6. **The institution has not submitted any details of the website being run by the institution.**

NOW THEREFORE, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Deccan B.Ed College, Noorani Moholla, Near Peer Bangali Darga, Ring Road, Gulbarga 585104, Karnataka** for conducting M.Ed. courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org), with 60 days from the date of issue of this order.
