Withdrawal Order

WHEREAS, the institution **Bethany Navajeevan College of Education, Bethany Nagar, Puthukkadai Vencode, Kanyakumari District - 629171, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/17173 dated 21.01.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 19.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC issued a Show Cause Notice on 17.09.2016. The institution has submitted a part reply of SCN on 29.09.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 380th meeting passed a Common decision to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institutions which have not yet submitted reply or submitted partial reply to the Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 22.11.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its reply along with documents on dt. 18.12.2019

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 05th & 06th January 2021 and considered the matter as under: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

1. The institute submitted copies of Sale Deeds dt.27.09.2007 and 12.02.2001 in favour of "Bethny Navajeevan Province" whereas the name of managing trust is "Bethany Navajeevan Trust" which is the different one and is not allowed under NCTE Regulations.
2. Other documents such as NEC, BCC, Building Plan, LUC etc. can not be accepted on the face of deficiency of land documents.
3. The institute also submitted a copy of Lease Agreement dt. 03.04.2012 between private parties which is not acceptable and allowed under NCTE Regulations.

4. Notarized English Translation of NEC has not been submitted.
5. The Building Plan submitted by the institute is neither legible nor approved by the competent authority.
6. The institute submitted a copy of letter dt.15.12.2007 issued by the Registrar, TTEU regarding approval of 16 faculty along with the proforma. All faculty members are shown to be appointed after the notification of NCTE (amendment) Regulations, 2014 and as they are not possessing NEC qualification are not qualified.
7. Website of the institute is not functional and required information have not been uploaded.

Now Therefore, the Committee decided to **Bethany Navajeevan College of Education, Bethany Nagar, Puthukkadai Vencode, Kanyakumari District – 629171, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed.** course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org with 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
