WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to **AIM College of Education for Women, C.M.C No. 1-1-171, Rao Taleem, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** for B.Ed. course vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/17411 dt. 29.01.2008 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the NCTE Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 were notified on 01.12.2014 in supersession of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2009.

AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the duration of the B.Ed. course was increased from one year to two years and the existing institutions offering B.Ed. course, of one-year duration, were required to give their acceptance, in the form of an affidavit, for adherence of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, as per the records, the recognition was granted to the institution on the rented / temporary premise with the condition to shift the premise to owned by trust/institution within a period of 3 years from the date of recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the records show that the institution had neither submitted any application for shifting of premise not obtained prior permission for shifting of premise from NCTE till date which is violation under the Act of NCTE Regulations 2002,3(c).

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 24.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 26.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.** The institution has submitted compliance against RPRO issued in respect of B.Ed. course on dt. 30.07.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 321st Meeting held on 28th to 30th September 2016 the matter was placed before the Committee and decided as a SCN was issued to the institution. Accordingly, as per directed a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 14.10.2016. The institution has submitted a written representation on dt. 08.11.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 329th Meeting of SRC, 06th & 07th February 2017 and the matter was placed before the Committee and decided to issue a letter was to the institution. Accordingly, as per directed a decision letter was issued to the institution on dt. 13.02.2017.

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AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st October-01st November, 2019 and 387th meeting held on 24-25th August, 2020 decided that a SCN be issued in all such matters which have not complied with the conditions mentioned in the RPRO.

AND WHEREAS, the institution is required / directed to submit the representation/compliance accompanied with an affidavit from the authorized representation of the Management. The representation along with an affidavit and reasons for non-submission of application for shifting in NCTE must reach this office within one month from the date of issue of this Notice.

1. Application for shifting of premise as per the prescribed format.
2. Prescribed fee of Rs. 1.5 Lakhs in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Member Secretary, NCTE (payable at New Delhi) towards processing of application for shifting of premise.

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of decision taken by the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st October & 01st November 2019 and 387th Meeting held on 24th & 25th August 2020, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 31.08.2020. Thereafter, a written representation was received from the institution on dt. 05.10.2020 against reply for Final Show Cause Notice dt. 31.08.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 5th - 6th January, 2021 considered and decided as the following grounds:

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

1. **The institution has not responded to the Final Show Cause Notice issued on 31.08.2020.**

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **AIM College of Education for Women, C.M.C No. 1-1-149, Rao Taleem, Bidar, Karnataka-585401** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby **withdraws recognition of AIM College of Education for Women, C.M.C No. 1-1-171, Rao Taleem, Bidar, Karnataka-585401 for B.Ed. course vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/17411 dt. 29.01.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.**

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

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"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order Withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, through "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org, within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
