WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sidhartha B.Ed. College, House No. 8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar, Karnataka-585328 run by Panchasheela Eduations Trust, House No. 8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2009/RO/14865 dt. 30.07.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2009-2010.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 30.07.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 25.04.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the SCN.

AND WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee of the SRC in 380th Meeting decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 08.11.2019 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice along with the documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 383rd Meeting held on 07th to 09th January 2020 the matter was placed, and the Committee decided to Withdraw the Recognition to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision Withdrawal Order was issued vide order no. F.SRC/NCTE/APS08819/B.Ed./115209-115215 on dt. 25.02.2020. The Appellate Authority in NCTE vide order dt. 23.11.2020 remanded back the case of the institute to SRC.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 5th-6th January 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee noted that the institution has not submitted any representation to the SRO within stipulated time period of 15 days given by the Appellate Authority vide its order dt. 23.11.2020.

Hence, the Committee decided that the withdrawal order issued on 25.02.2020 for conducting B.Ed course shall remain effective which was decided by the SRC in its 383 rd Meeting held on 07th to 09th January 2020."

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby orders that withdrawal order dt. 20.01.2020 in respect of **Sidhartha B.Ed. College, House No. 8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar, Karnataka-585328** run by **Panchasheela Eduations Trust, House No. 8, Mig-II, Housing Board Colony, Bhalki, Bidar Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order shall remain effective.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
