ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution Stanley College of Education, Mookareddipatti, A. Pallipatti Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu-636905 was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/15440 dt. 30.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted on dt. 13.05.2015 by the institution and the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on dt. 25.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by SRC. On perusal of the records, it is found that the institution is required to submit the documents.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 03.02.2020. The institution submitted its reply along with documents on dt. 17.02.2020. The above reply was placed before the SRC in its 386th held on 23rd & 24th July 2020. The Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution to submit the written representation against the conditions mentioned therein.

AND WHEREAS, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on dt. 04.08.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 11.08.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 387th Meeting held on 24th & 25th August 2020 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision Withdrawal Order was issued vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS08130/B.Ed./TN/2020/117279-7285 on dt. 01.09.2020 on the following grounds: -

1. The institution has submitted LUC wherein it has been mentioned that "institution building is under construction".

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2. The institution has submitted BCC but the same is not approved by the competent authority.
3. The Building Plan submitted by the institution is not approved by the competent authority.

AND WHEREAS, the Appellate Authority in NCTE vide order dt. 23.12.2020, remanded back the case of the institute to SRC. The operative part of the order is reproduced below: -

"AND WHEREAS the Committee, noting that the appellant submitted the documents found wanting in the order of withdrawal, concluded that the matter deserved to be remanded to the SRC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal, to be sent to them by the appellant, and take further necessary action as per NCTE Regulation, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward to the SRC, the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days of issue of orders on the appeal.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee concluded to remand back the case to SRC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal, to be sent to them by the appellant, and take further necessary action as per NCTE Regulation, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward to the SRC, the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days of issue of orders on the appeal.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Stanley College of Education, Mook Areddipatti, Dharmapuri, TamilNadu to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.

AND WHEREAS, as per Hearing Committee Instructions, the institution has submitted deficiencies rectified documents on dt. 29.12.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the compliance submitted by the institution on dt. 29.12.2020 and the matter was considered by the SRC in its 393rd Meeting held on 05th & 06th January 2021 as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Stanley College of Education, Mookareddipatti, A. Pallipatti Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu-636905** for the following courses: -

- (i) **B.Ed. – 2 units (50 students each unit).**
- (ii) **M.Ed. – 1 unit of 50 students."**

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NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., **Stanley College of Education, S. No. 28/10A, 10B, 10C, 11B, 12A, 12B, 12C, 29/2B, Mookareddipatti Village, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District, Tamilnadu-636905** for **B.Ed. course** run by **Stanley Educational Trust, 42, Majid Steet, Mookareddipatti Village, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District, Tamilnadu-636905** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units)** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
 - V. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
14. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
 15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 16. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
 - a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:


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- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
17. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
18. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
19. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
