WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Nethaji College of Education, No.27, Arehalli, Ittamadu Main Road, Banashankari 3rd Stage, Bangalore – 560061, Karnataka** run by **Nethaji Smaraka Vidyakendra Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2004-2005/8834 dt 30.11.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the institution in its letter dated 08.10.2007 has submitted a proposal for shifting of premises along with Rs.40,000/- towards shifting fee. Inspection was carried out on 25th October 2010. The SRC in its 198th meeting held on 24-26 November 2010 considered the VT report and all the relevant documentary evidence and it was decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 19.01.2011. The institution has submitted its written representation on 11.02.2011. Further, the institution has submitted Rs.40,000/- for change of name from “Nethaji College of Education” to “SJB College of Education”.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 201st meeting held on 22-23 February 2011 considered the written representation and decided to permit the institution to shift to new/permanent premises. In the light of the above, the minutes need to be reviewed. The case was reviewed in 205th meeting of SRC and the committee decided not to permit as it involves shifting of institution from one place to another. Under the above norms and logic/rationale, the Committee considered the request of the institution and decided that the request for shifting cannot be complied with and change of Management is also not permissible under NCTE Act and regulations. The order was issued on 09.08.2010.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 22.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, on 09.09.2015, the institution has submitted a request for one unit. As 292nd meeting held during 29th -30th September 2015 and the SRC considered the requisition for change of intake and decided to issue corrigendum. As per decision Corrigendum issued to institution on 09.12.2015. The matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.4.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 375th Meeting of SRC held on 3rd and 4th May, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue withdrawal order to the institution. Accordingly, a Withdrawal order vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO1718/B.Ed/KA/2019/104758-64 dt. 30.05.2019 was issued to the institution. Aggrieved with the order of the SRC, NCTE, the institution filed a WP no. 31071 of 2019 before the hon'ble High Court of Karnataka at Bangalore.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 384th meeting held on 12th-13th February 2020 considered the matter and decided to write a letter to the institution asking therein to submit the documents. Accordingly, the letter was issued to the institution on 26.02.2020. The institution vide letter dated 23.03.2020 & 03.06.2020 submitted its reply to the letter.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th-16th December 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee noted the reply submitted by the institution on 23.03.2020 & 03.06.2020 in respect to the last reminder letter, and the Committee made following observations: -

- (i) The institution has submitted notarized copy of land document. However, the institution has not submitted certified copy of land document.*
- (ii) The institution has not submitted LUC duly approved by the competent authority.*
- (iii) The institution has not submitted BCC in prescribed format as directed by NCTE.*
- (iv) The institution has submitted computerized generated copy of NEC. The institution has not submitted notarized English version of NEC.*
- (v) The institution has not submitted original blueprints of the Building Plan & Site Plan duly approved by the competent authority. The institution has submitted photocopy of the same which is not legible. The size of the Total Built up area, classrooms & Multipurpose Hall are not reflecting properly.*
- (vi) The institution has submitted an approval letter dt 28.05.2020 duly signed by the Registrar of Bangalore University. However, the institution has not submitted proforma of the staff in prescribed format as directed by NCTE.*
- (vii) The institution has not submitted copy of Form 'A' issued by the branch manager. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.*

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Nethaji College of Education, No. 27, Arehalli, Ittamadu Main Road, Banashankari 3rd State, Bangalore 560061, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed** courses w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."*

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **Nethaji College of Education, No.27, Arehalli, Ittamadu Main Road, Banashankari 3rd Stage, Bangalore – 560061, Karnataka** run by **Nethaji Smaraka Vidyakendra Trust, Bangalore, Karnataka** for


conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the next academic session starts after issuance of this order.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
