ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Shri Tangaturi Prakasham Memorial Government Institute of Advanced Study in Education, Santhapet, Nellore – 524001, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/B.Ed/03/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001 / 1334 dt 27.07.2000 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 125 students from the academic session 2000-2001.

2. AND WHEREAS, based on the performance appraisal report, the enhancement of intake from existing 125 to 160 was permitted for the session 2003-2004 vide SRC, NCTE's letter no. F.AP/EXT/SEC / 82/SRO/NCTE/2003-04 / 2144 dt. 03.03.2003.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 294th meeting held on 14 – 16th November 2015 considered the matter. The Committee noticed that the institution has not submitted Affidavit adhering to Regulations, 2014 and hence not issued Revised Order and decided to issue Show Cause Notice for withdrawal of recognition under NCTE Act for the following deficiency: -

- **Affidavit not submitted affirming adherence to Regulations, 2014.**

4. AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016. On 01.06.2016 the Principal, STPM Govt. Institute of Advanced Study in Education has submitted a request as under: -

"As per the reference cited above, the original affidavit for B.Ed and M.Ed had been already sent to the Regional Director, SRC, NCTE, Bangalore on 23.05.2016 and also mailed the same to the office I here with enclose the Xerox copy for reference, Please consider the request and grant the permission as early as possible".

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 319th Meeting of SRC held on 30th – 31st August 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under: -

1. They had given the affidavits in May 2016.

2. Issuing RPRO at this stage will create avoidable complications. The institution, by its delayed submission of affidavits, is responsible for this situation.
- 2.2. It is not clear how any RPRO was issued for M.Ed even before the Affidavit was received
3. Ask them to convert the courses to conform to norms / standards under the new Regulations, 2014 in 2 months.
4. Collect fees for the 2 inspections and cause composite inspection by 15.11.2016.
5. Ask VT to collect all relevant documents for B.Ed (2 units) and M.Ed (1 unit).

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the above matter was deliberated again in the SRC meeting in its 395th meeting held on 25th – 26th February, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The Committee perused the matter of the institute and decided to write a letter to the Secretary, AP State Council for Higher Education, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Amrawati to make admission in IASE, Nellore for the academic session 2020-2021.

The Committee also decided that an order to this effect be also uploaded in the SRC, Website immediately. Further a Show Cause Notice on standard 13 points be served on the institution for considering the issuance of RPRO. "

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, the institution **Shri Tangaturi Prakasham Memorial Government Institute of Advanced Study in Education, Santhapet, Nellore – 524001, Andhra Pradesh** is allowed to conduct **B.Ed course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **2 basic units** (50 students each unit) for the academic session 2020 - 21 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- II. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation form the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- III. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.



9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information regarding the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
