ORDER 121148 - 1154 WHEREAS, the institution Smt. Hemavathi Kuvempu Women's B.Ed. College, K.B. Extention, Near Fort, Chitradurga, Karnataka was granted recognition on dt. 22.12.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of two year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, on 02.07.2012, the Principal of the institution has requested for grant of permission of the college with co-education. The Principal has also enclosed an approval of the Under Secretary to Govt., Education Department, Bangalore for conversion of Women B.Ed college to Co-Education College and has permitted to change the name with certain conditions. On 30.07.2012, the institution has again requested for change of Women's College into Co-Ed. College along with Rs. 50,000/- Demand Draft for the same.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 230th meeting held on 16th – 17th July, 2012 considered the request of the management to permit the management for converting the existing institution Smt. Hemavathi Kuvempu Womens B.Ed College, K.B. Extension, Near Fort, Chitradurga, Karnataka (APS02525) into a co-educational institution from the academic year 2012-2013. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC an order was issued to the institution on 10.09.2012.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted by the institution on dt. 06.02.2015, the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2015-16. The institution has submitted approved faculty list on 14.06.2016.

AND WHEREAS, on 11.11.2016, the institution has submitted a request letter for 2 units. The SRC in its 343rd meeting held on 1st & 2nd August 2017 considered the matter and decided to "Put up in next meeting on 17.08.2017. Again the SRC in its 344th meeting held on 17-18 August 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 09.09.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 04.10.2019. The institutions vide letter dated 09.12.2019 submitted reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> -25<sup>th</sup> August 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 01.09.2020. The institution vide letter dated 10.12.2020 submitted its to the Final Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup>-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were

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On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Smt. Hemavathi Kuvempu Women's B.Ed. College, K.B. Extention, Near Fort, Chitradurga, Karnataka for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit."

NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., Smt. Hemavathi Kuvempu Women's B.Ed. College, Survey No. - 19/2, K.B. Extension, Near Fort, Chitradurga, Karnataka for B.Ed. course run by Bapuji Education Society, Chitradurga District, Karnataka for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint I. account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed II. in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the III. examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly IV. approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in V.
- The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in
- Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be 10. prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the 11. end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by 12.
- The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:
  - a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.

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- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and 13. display up-to-date information on its official website.
- The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website. 14.
- The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. 15.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
