ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution Akshaya College of Teacher Education, Survey No.15/03, 04, Plot No. 161, Baddihalli Village, Oordigere Hobli, Tumkur District-572102, Karnataka was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2008/7665 dated 04.12.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 02.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, on 05.07.2016, an e-mail is received from the Legal section of NCTE, New Delhi enclosing a letter from Dr. Sumita Das Majumdar, Under Secretary, NCTE, New Delhi regarding Court order dated 28.01.2014 in W.P. No. 57828 of 2012 filed by Akshaya College of Teacher Education Vs Tumkur University and others with a request to send a copy of the appeal, appellate order or any other reference in the regard.

AND WHEREAS, on 25.07.2016, NCTE hqrs forwarded a VT report conducted u/s 13 of NCTE act to this office in respect of Akshaya College of Teacher Education, Tumkur along with a DVD.

AND WHEREAS, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22nd October 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply has been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 30.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 23.11.2019 submitted its reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

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AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on 15th – 16th December, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Akshaya College of Teacher Education, Plot No. 161, Baddihalli Village, Oordigere Hobli, Tumkur District-572102, Karnataka for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit.”

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Akshaya College of Teacher Education, Survey No.15/03, 04, Plot No. 161, Baddihalli Village, Oordigere Hobli, Tumkur District-572102, Karnataka** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
1. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
 2. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

3. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

4. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

5. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

6. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section. 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
