**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the institution Vel College of Education, No.7/4, Jawahar Nagar, New Dharapuram Road, Palani-624601, Dindigul District, Tamil Nadu was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/14239 dt. 07.11.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

**AND WHEREAS**, the committee considered the matter in its 197<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> October 2010 and decided to cause inspection. Inspection of the institution was fixed 30.16-17<sup>th</sup> November 2010, but inspection of the institution could not be conducted as the institution vide its fax dated 29.10.2010 requested to postpone the inspection date for another four months. Accordingly, inspection of the institution was fixed between 24<sup>th</sup> January 2011 and was intimated to the institution on 17.01.2011. Inspection of the institution for shifting of premises was conducted on 08.02.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the committee in its 201<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> February 2011 considered the VT Report and decided to serve Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE act. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued on 05.04.2011. The institution submitted its reply to the Show Cause Notice on 05.05.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 205<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18-19<sup>th</sup> May 2011 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, Withdrawal order was issued on 27.07.2011. A letter has been received from the NCTE, New Delhi on 26.08.2011 seeking comments and to forward the original application file to the institution for consideration of appeal preferred by the institution. Accordingly, a letter to NCTE, Hqrs forwarding comments along with original application file is issued on 30.08.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 214<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2011 scheduled the inspection of the institution. Accordingly, inspection letter was issued to the institution on 14.12.2011. the inspection was conducted on 29.12.2011.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 216<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11-12<sup>th</sup> January 2012 considered the VT Report of the institution and other related documents along with the original file of the institution for shifting to new/permanent premises and decided to permit shifting to new premises. Accordingly, shifting order was issued to the institution on 25.02.2012.

**AND WHEREAS**, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted by the institution on dt. 09.03.2015, the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 20.03.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2015-16.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 314<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2016, decided to conduct VT inspection. Accordingly, inspection letter was issued to the institution on 22.06.2016.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue First Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, First

Show Cause Notice was issued on 23.09.2020. The institution submitted its reply to the First Show Cause Notice on 14.12.2020.

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> December 2020 as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Vel College of Education, New Dharmapuram, Puliampatti Post, Palani Taluk, Dindigul District, 624601, Tamil nadu** for B.Ed programme for **2 basic units of 50 students each unit.**"

**NOW THEREFORE**, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., **Vel College of Education, Survey No.- 118/1, 210/1A2, Jawahar Nagar, New Dharapuram Road, Palani-624601, Dindigul District, Tamil Nadu** for B.Ed. course run by **VEL Charitable Trust, Dindigul District, Tamil Nadu** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units)** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
  - V. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
  13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such

as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
  - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
  - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
  - e. Fee charged from students.
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
  - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.
- If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
