WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution K.L.E. Society's College of Education, Shedgeri, Near Sundaranarayana Temple Road, Ankola, Uttara Kananada District, Karnataka-581314 run by K.L.E Society, Belgaum, Karnataka vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/1254 dt. 10.03.2005 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 28.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 18.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 19.08.2020. The Institution has not submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC as per decision taken in its 380th Meeting. The Sub-Committee of the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 23.10.2020. Thereafter, the institution has submitted reply on 03.11.2020

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 400th Meeting held on 13th & 14th July 2021 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 03.11.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies: -

1. The Building Plan submitted by the institute is not approved by the competent authority and also establishes the size of M.P. Hall as 1600 sq. ft. which is less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations 2014.



2. The institution has submitted notarized copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate in regional language. NEC with notarized English translation has not been submitted.
3. The institute had submitted proforma signed by the affiliating body regarding approval of faculty but faculties namely Praveena N. Nayak, Amreena Shaikh, Swati Ankolekar are not qualified with NET as required under NCTE's notification dt. 09.06.2017 and joined after that date.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to K.L.E. Society's College of Education, Shedgeri, Near Sundaranarayana Temple Road, Ankola, Uttara Kananada District, Karnataka-581314** for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **K.L.E. Society's College of Education, Shedgeri, Near Sundaranarayana Temple Road, Ankola, Uttara Kananada District, Karnataka-581314** run by K.L.E. Society, Belgaum, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
