**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution Deccan College of Education for Women, Hafarga Cross, Ring Road, Near KCT Engineering College, Gulbarga, Karnataka-585104 vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4953 dt. 24.12.2005 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 16.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the inspection was conducted on 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 VT report received on 26.10.2016. The SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> October to 01<sup>st</sup> November 2019 has considered the matter and decided to issue First Show Cause Notice to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.09.2019. The institution has not submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.01.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 06.01.2021.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 400<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide dated 06.01.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies: -

1. The institute submitted a letter dt. 27.01.2021 issued by the UDA, Kalaburagi against LUC Which mentions that the land falls under Park (Green) zone in Master Plan-II but do not mention about use of land for Educational Purpose.
2. Latest NEC not submitted.
3. Building Plan shows non availability of M.P. Hall.
4. The institute submitted a proforma signed by the Registrar, KSAW University along with approval letter dt. 05.05.2020. Total faculty approved is 16 but faculty namely Basera Tahseen Fatima is not qualified as not possessing NET qualification and appointed after 09.06.2017 i.e., the date of NCTE notification.



5. Faculty approved on 05.05.2020 and shown to be appointed in 2012,2014 etc. It is not clear that whether same faculty is still working in the College or not. The institute is required to submit the bank statement showing disbursement of salary to faculty since last 5 years.
6. The institute submitted following false/fabricated documents/information: -
- (i) Faculty namely Nayeemunnisa shown to be appointed on 01.01.2015 but was not approved in letter dt. 04.01.2015 issued by the KSW university.
  - (ii) Miss Geeta shown to be appointed on 21.11.2014 but was not appointed in letter dt. 04.11.2015 issued by the KSW University.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Deccan College of Education for Women, Hafarga Cross, Ring Road, Near KCT Engineering College, Gulbarga-585104, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."


6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Deccan College of Education for Women, Hafarga Cross, Ring Road, Near KCT Engineering College, Gulbarga-585104, Karnataka** run by **Deccan Education Society, Noorani Colony Near Peer Bengali Dargah, Gulbarga, Karnataka** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

*"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."*

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
