WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, St. Peter's College of Education, Karumathampatti, Coimbatore-641659, TamilNadu vide SRC order No.F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/9856 dated 28.12.2006 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has consented to come under new Regulations notarized affidavit dated 28.01.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 30.04,2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 343rd meeting held on 1st 2nd August 2017 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC order No. F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS04956 /B.Ed./TN/2017-18/94846 was issued to the institution on 12.09.2017 reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided to issue a Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.08.2019. The institution vide letter dated 12.09.2019 has submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 397th meeting held on 25th 26th March 2021 has considered the and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.04.2021. The institution has submitted reply received on 31.05.2021.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 400th meeting held on July 13th 14th, 2021 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 31.05.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of LUC in regional language. The institution is required to submit an English translated copy of it.
- 2. The institution has not submitted NEC.
- 3. The institution has submitted a lease deed executed on 13.12.2005 & a Sale Deed executed on 2.02.1933 having Sy. No. 460/3 & 460/1 at the time of Recognition and now another lease deed submitted executed on 15.06.2006. This is not permissible under NCTE Regulations 2014.
- 4. The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of a building plan in which site area and multi-purpose area are not mentioned.
- 5. The institution has not submitted a site plan.
- 6. A letter dated 30.06.2009 has submitted was approved by Executive officer instead of Building Completion Certificate.
- 7. The institution has not appointed a Fine Arts, Performing Arts & Physical Education Staff.
- 8. Five Lecturers does not have NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.
- 9. The faculty have not been approved by the affiliating body which is a mandatory requirement of NCTE Regulations.
- 10. The institution has not submitted a Form "A" issued by the Branch Manager.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to St. Peter's College of Education, Karumathampatti, Coimbatore-641659, TamilNadu for conducting B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above".

- 7. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to St. Peter's College of Education, Karumathampatti, Coimbatore-641659, TamilNadu run by The Coimbatore Diocese Society, Coimbatore-641659, TamilNadu for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) w.e.f. the next academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.
- 8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
