WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Venkateshwara College of Education, H.No. 1-56/A, Near Bus Depo, Dubbak Village & Mandal, Medak- 502108, Andhra Pradesh run by Sri Venkateshwara Educational Society, Medak District, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/5268 dated 26.11.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had submitted affidavit dated 18.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in 381th meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT Report accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 25.11.2019. The institution did not submitted reply to the First Show Cause Notice till date.
- **4. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 05th-06th January 2021 considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 08.01.2021. The institution vide letter dated 12.02.2021 submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 400th Meeting held on 13th & 14th July, 2021 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide dated 12.02.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

1. The institution has submitted notarized copy of land document as Gift Settlement Deed. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land document issued by the concerned authority.

2. The institution has not submitted notarized copy of Land Use Certificate.

3. The institution has not submitted notarized copy of NEC.

4. The institution has not submitted notarized copy of approved building plan & Site plan.

5. The institution has not submitted Form A with the copy of FDR. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.

6. Domain name is not mentioned by the institution.

7. Faculty list is submitted for 12 faculty members, which is not sufficient for 100 students (two basic units).

a) The principal does not possess Ph.D. degree.

b) 4 out of 9 faculties have been shown appointed after 09.06.2017, thus not having NET as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.

8. The institution also recognised for B.P.Ed and D.El.Ed programme in respect of File No. SRCAPP249 and SRCAPP1652 respectively. But institution has not submitted any information of approved faculty and other infrastructure detail as per Regulation 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Sri Venkateshwara College of Education, H.No. 1-56/A, Near Bus Depo, Dubbak Village & Mandal, Medak- 502108, Telangana for conducting B.Ed., B.P.Ed. & D.El.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Sri Venkateshwara College of Education, H.No. 1-56/A, Near Bus Depo, Dubbak Village & Mandal, Medak- 502108, Telangana run by Sri Venkateshwara Educational Society, Medak District, Telangana for B.Ed. Programme with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
