SHITING /CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Senthil College of Education, No.36, Thiyagaraja Street, Pondicherry-605001** vide order No. F. PN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-06/4345 dated 28.11.2005 for conducting **B.Ed. Course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dated 05.02.2015 for its willingness & adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 13.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Corrigendum vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS02970/B.Ed./PO/2015-16/85648 was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016 for grants recognition to **Senthil College of Education, No. 36, Thiyagaraja Street, Pondicherry-605001** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 388th Meeting held on 14th& 15th September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT Repost accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause was issued to the institution on 06.10.2020. The institution vide letter dated 23.10.2020 has submitted a reply to the Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 397th meeting held on 25th – 26th March 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 07.04.2021. The institution vide letter dated 21.04.2021 has submitted a reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 419th Meeting held on 13th January, 2023 (P-880-881/Coors.) has considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Withdrawal Order No. F.SRC/NCTE/APS02970/B.Ed./PO/2023/140420-140424 was issued to the institution on 31.01.2023

7. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-78/E-

300886/2023 Appeal/5th Meeting, 2023 APPLSRC202314594 dt. 22.05.2023 appeal remand back the order appealed against.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 426th Meeting held on 23th June, 2023 has considered the matter and decided constitute the **online Visiting Team** for inspection of infrastructural & instructional facilities etc.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi bearing W.P (C) No. 9861/2023 titled as Senthil College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education and Anr. whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed vide order dated 27.07.2023.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the Court order dated 27.07.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and order dated 22.05.2023 passed by Appellate Committee, the Regional Director SRC has been issued a restoration order on 02.08.2023 vide order no. F.SRC.NCTE/APSO2970/B.Ed./2023/143050-52.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the inspection was conducted by the office of SRC with three VT Members namely, Dr. M.T.V. Nagaraju, Dr. Pramood Kumar Yadav and Prof. Himanshu Poptani on 26.07.2023.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 428th meeting held on 25th August 2023 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.08.2023. The institution vide letter dated 04.10.2023 has submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 431st meeting held on 10th January, 2024 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the institution namely **Senthil College of Education** decided that **shifting of premises be permitted to the institution at new address i.e. Re Survey No. 158/2, 158/3 & 158/8C, Door No. 42, Guruvappanaicken Palayam Village No. 33, Villianur Commune, District Puducherry-605110. The Committee also decided that continuation order be issued to the Institution for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each."***

14. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Senthil College of Education**, No.36, Thiyagaraja Street, Pondicherry-605001 **to shift its building at new address at Re Survey No. 158/2, 158/3 & 158/8C, Door No. 42, Guruvappanaicken Palayam Village No. 33, Villianur Commune, District Puducherry-605110.** Further as per the decision of the



SRC, an order for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of (two units) of 50 students each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

15. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

16. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

17. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.



k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

18. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

19. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.


20. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.


