WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **St. Josephs Teacher Training College, Plot/Khasara No.357-1,356-2B, B. L. Road, Kirikera Village & Post, Hindupur Taluk & City, Anantapur District 515211, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Balayesu Educational Society, Plot No. 19-2-75, Nimkampalli Road, Hindupur Post Office, Taluk and Town, Anantpur District-515201, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **D.El.Ed & D.El.Ed-AI course** following teacher training courses: -

- (i) The SRC vide Order No. SRCAPP717/D.El.Ed/AP/2012/45580 dated 27.08.2012 for conducting D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic sessions 2012-2013.
- (ii) The SRC vide order No. SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP3052/D.El.Ed-AI/AP/2016/84166 dated 12.04.2016 for conducting D.El.Ed-AI. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic sessions 2016-2017.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted vide letter dated 19.06.2021 a letter submission of closing Institution as following:-

"...I here with submit the Society members are resolved that St. Josephs Teacher Training College (F.No.SRCAPP717/D.El.Ed/AP/2012/45580 dated 27.08.2012) Plot/Khasara No.357-1, 356-2B, B.L.Road, Kirikera (V), Hindupur (M), Anantapuramu (Dist)-AP Closure of Institution proposals and also submitted along with necessary documents."

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 400th Meeting held on 13th & 14th July 2021 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee agreed to close down the institution as requested by the institution vide dated 19.06.2021 by withdrawing the recognition granted to **St. Josephs Teacher Training College, Plot/Khasara No.356-2B, B.L.Road, Kirikera Village & Post, Hindupur Taluk & City, Anantapur District 515211, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **D.El.Ed. & D.El.Ed.-AI** programme under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2021-2022.

However, the FDRs towards Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) for encashment of FDRs will be issued by the Regional Director on the submission of the following:

- (a) NOC from the affiliating body.
- (b) NOC from the staff/faculty.
- (c) Resolution of the management to the effect for closure of the course"

5. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of **St. Josephs Teacher Training College, Plot/Khasara No.356-2B, B. L. Road, Kirikera Village & Post, Hindupur Taluk & City, Anantapur District 515211, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Balayesu Educational Society, Plot No. 19-2-75, Nimkampalli Road, Hindupur Post Office, Taluk and Town, Anantpur District-515201, Andhra Pradesh** for **D.El.Ed & D.El.Ed-AI** Programme with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
