**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, recognition u/s14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Vignan College of Education, Nizampet, Opp. JNTU, New KPHB, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Lavu Educational Trust, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/665 dated 12.04.2007 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 30.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16 on 12.05.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct & 01<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2019 has considered the matter and the decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT report accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.11.2019. The management of the institution has not submitted a reply to the First Show Cause Notice till the date.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 10.05.2022. The management of the institution has not submitted the reply of Final Show Cause Notice till the date.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SRC held on 03<sup>rd</sup> – 04<sup>th</sup> November 2022 considered the matter for non-submission of reply to Final Show Cause Notice and decided as under: -

***"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -***

(i) ***The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice dated 10.05.2022.***

***Hence the recognition granted to Vignan College of Education, Nizampet, Opp. JNTU, New KPHB, Hyderabad, Telangana for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of next***


***academic session i.e. 2023-2024. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn”.***

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Vignan College of Education, Nizampet, Opp. JNTU, New KPHB, Hyderabad, Telangana** for conducting **B.Ed. Programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** with effect from the end of next academic session i.e., 2023-2024.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

***“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”***

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
