ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution Subramanya College of Education, Herohalli Village, No. 63, BEL Layout, Viswanedam Post, Off. Magadi Road, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560091 was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2004-2005/9091 dated 24.12.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

AND WHEREAS, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavits submitted by the institution on dt. 05.06.2015 and the provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.10.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 18.03.2019. **The institution did not reply to Show Cause Notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 377th Meeting held on 03rd & 04th July 2019 considered the matter and decide to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, as per directed a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 15.07.2019. **The institution did not reply to Final Show Cause Notice till date.**

AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 382nd Meeting held on 26th & 27th November, 2019 the matter was placed and the Committee decided to **Withdraw the Recognition** to the institution for not submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice.

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AND WHEREAS, as per the decision Withdrawal Order was issued vide order no. F.SRC/NCTE/APS02253/B.Ed./KA/2019-112973-2979 on dt. 10.12.2019. The Appellate Authority in NCTE vide order dt. 16.09.2020 remanded back the case of the institute to SRC. The operative part of the order is reproduced below: -

“AND WHEREAS Appeal Committee noted that appellant institution was granted recognition to conduct B.Ed. course with an intake of 100 seats in the year 2004. Revised recognition order dt. 31/10/2015 was issued to appellant institution under NCTE Regulation, 2014 for an intake of 2 units (50+50). Appeal Committee noted that a Show Cause Notice (SCN) dt. 18/03/2019 was issued to appellant institution seeking compliance in terms of Regulation, 2014 which included submission of (i) revalidated FDRs, (ii) creation of additional facilities including additional built up area, additional faculty, additional infrastructure. Appellant states to have not received the SCN dt. 18.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS Appeal Committee noted that appellant admitted having received the 2nd SCN dt. 15.07.2019 in the first week of September 2019. Appellant with its appeal memoranda has submitted copies of (i) land documents, (ii) Building Completion Certificate (Built up area of 46000 sq. ft.), (iii) list of faculty approved by affiliating body in July, 2019, (iv) FDRs in joint name with Regional Director, SRC, (v) Site Plan, (vi) N.E.C etc. Appeal Committee noted from the copies of documents submitted by appellant that these documents pertain to a period before the date of impugned order of withdrawal. Appellant during its online presentation also stated that a reply to SCN was sent by speed post on dt. 25/11/2019. However, no such reply is found placed in the regulatory file.

AND WHEREAS Appeal Committee decided that appellant institution is required to submit a consolidated reply to the SCN enclosing therewith copies of all the required documents within 15 days of the issue of appeal order. Appeal Committee further decided to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Subramanya College of Education, Viswanedam, Magadi Road, Bangalore, Karnataka to the SRC, NCTE for necessary action as indicated above.”

Therefore, as per Hearing Committee Instructions, the institution has submitted deficiencies rectified documents on dt. 01.10.2020

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th & 14th October, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 05.10.2020, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Subramanya College of Education, No. 63, BEL Layout, Viswaneedam Post, Off. Magadi Road, Bangalore, Karnataka-560091** for **B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit.”**

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Subramanya College of Education, Herohalli Village, No. 63, BEL Layout, Viswaneedam Post, Off. Magadi Road, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560091** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
1. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
 2. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

3. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
4. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
5. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
6. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
