PREAMBLE:

Dr. Zakir Hussain College of Education, Mulukunduru Village, Ponnur Mandal, Dompalapudela, Guntur Dt. - 522 315, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed course on 7/12/2004. A visiting team was sent to the institution on 12.3.2005 and the report was placed before 90th SRC meeting held on 17-18 March 2005. SRC decided to issue a notice and the notice was served to the institution on 31.3.2005 to remove the deficiencies mentioned as under:-

1. The College building has only asbestos roofing
2. Staff list approved by the Registrar of the affiliating University is not submitted.

The institution has submitted its reply with supporting documents for fulfillment of the above two deficiencies on 8.4.2005 and 27.4.2005.

A one man verification team was sent to the institution on 21.5.2005 to verify the claims made by the institution in its replies. The verification report was placed in 92nd SRC meeting held on 26-27th May 2005. SRC decided to defer the matter for want of additional details/clarifications. The matter came up for consideration in 94th meeting of SRC held on 24th June, 2005 and SRC decided to get the following details:-

- a) Land documents
- b) Endowment fund deposits
- c) Whether the location of college is shifted or not
- d) Has the institutions run by management is blacklisted by the Government? If so, the reasons for the same.

In the meanwhile, SRC, NCTE received the interim directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature, Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad in W.P.M.P.No.16837 of 2005 in W.P.No. 13262 of 2005 dated 11.7.2005 wherein it is stated that

"The Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to direct the 1st respondent(SRC,NCTE) to forthwith process and pass orders on the petitioners application for establishment of the 2nd petitioner institution pending W.P.No.13262 of 2005 on the file of the Hon'ble High Court. filed by the institution.

The Court while directing issue of notice to the respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.

ORDER

There shall be interim direction as prayed for, pending further orders. Notice."

The institution, on 18.7.2005 submitted a representation in response to the queries sought for by the institution. The matter was placed before SRC in its 100th meeting held on 23-24th September, 2005. SRC decided to accord recognition to the college from the session 2005-06 with an intake of 100 with a condition to submit duly approved staff list from the concerned affiliating University. Hence, the following order:-

Order

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Dr. Zakir Husain College of Education, Mulukunduru Village, Ponnur Mandal, Dompalapude(via), Guntur Dt. - 522 315, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Secondary (B.Ed)** Course of **One year** from the academic session 2005-06.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:-
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00. lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the **Principal and Seven teachers** for the said course.

3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Dr. Zahir Hussain College of Education, Mulaikunduru Village, Ponnur Mandal, Dompalapude(Via), Guntur Dt. - 522 315, Andhra Pradesh** to offer **Secondary(B.Ed)** course of **one year** duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of **100** students, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a) The institution will ensure that **Eight** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Seven teachers**) duly approved by the affiliating university are in position for an intake of 100 students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
- b) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- c) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
