ORDER

27 AUG 2020

WHEREAS, the institution namely Arasu College of Education for Women, Thiruvalluvar Nagar, Velayuthampalayam, Karur, Tamilnadu-639002 was granted recognition for conducting (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide SRC, NCTE's vide order no. F.SRONCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/13839 dt. 31.10.2007.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after the promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per affidavit submitted by the institution on dt. 23.01.2015 and the provisional revised recognition order was issued on dt. 27.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students each for two basic units from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted written representation on 31.10.2015 along with documents. The institution submitted faculty list on 29.02.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC its 314th meeting held on 27th & 28th May 2016 decided as under:

- *"For cases of B.Ed. (2 units) in the existing institution, where RPRO, has been issued, we have to cause inspection to check adherence to the 2014 Regulations. This action will have to be completed by July 2016 so that revised Formal Recognition can be issued w.e.f. 2016-2017 to enable them to make admission in time.*
- *Action to check the documents in these cases (about 1885 in number) will take time. Instead of Waiting for that action to be completed for placing them before the SRC, to save time, VT Inspections can straightaway be ordered. VT Inspection Report can be considered along with examination of the documents.*
- *Regional Director is authorized to initiate action accordingly. The institution concerned may be alerted about such action so that they will be prepared to receive the Visiting Teams. They may also be advised to keep in readiness latest approved Faculty Lists for Submission to the VTs."*

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter was issued to the institution for the inspection on dt. 14.06.2016. But inspection was not conducted till date. The matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its

380th meeting held on 18th & 19th September, 2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 14.10.2019. The institution submitted its reply vide letter dt. 12.11.2019 alongwith land & building documents having address as S.F. No. 261/A22C (Block 1) Panduthakaranpudur, Punjai Kadambankurichi Village, Manmangalan (Tk), Karuru District, Tamilnadu and staff list etc.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 387th meeting held on 24th – 25th August, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under;

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt 12.11.2019, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution Arasu College of Education for Women, Thiruvalluvar Nagar, Velayuthampalayam, Karur, Tamilnadu-639002 for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Arasu College of Education for Women, S.F.261/ A22C (Block 1), Panduthakaranpudur, Punjai Kadambankurichi Village, Manmangalam Taluk, Karur District-639006, Tamilnadu for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two year duration with an intake of 100 students (two units) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FIDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

9. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

11. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
12. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
13. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
14. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
