CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Kerala University College of Teacher Education, Government Boys High School, Kanyamkulam, Alappuzha District, Kerala-690502** vide order no. F.KL/SE/UNI/N/20/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/4865 dated 13.07.2004 for conducting Secondary course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 165 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 177th meeting held on 22nd -23rd June 2009 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition for B.Ed. course of the University centre from the academic session 2009-2010. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, the recognition accorded to the institution namely, Kerala University College of Teacher Education, Government Boys High School, Kanyamkulam, Alappuzha District-690502, Kerala for B.Ed. course was withdrawn vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2009-10/14551 dated 15.07.2009.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 254th meeting held on 25th-27th October 2013 considered the matter, and decided that "...the recognition given to the ten Teacher Education Centres of University of Kerala is continued and the University is given time till 2015-16 to remove the deficiencies in reference failing which, without further notice, the recognition given will be withdrawn." Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the Registrar, Kerala University and to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Government Secretariat, Higher Education (B) Department, Government of Kerala, Kerala on 29.11.2013.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, after consideration of the matter by the SRC in its 272nd meeting held on 01st & 02nd September 2014, the recognition of Kerala University College of Teacher Education, Government Boys High School, Kayamkulam, Alappuzha District-690502, Kerala for B.Ed. course was withdrawn from the academic session 2014-2015 vide order no. F.No.APSO2952/B.Ed/KL/2014/59928 on 15.10.2014.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, after consideration of the matter by the SRC in its 288th meeting held on 31st May, 2015, the recognition for B.Ed. course in each of the ten university centres was restored with an intake of 50 students (one unit).

6. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 02.06.2015 for its willingness for B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 08.07.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 Students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.02.2019. The institution has submitted its reply on 02.05.2019.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 417th Meeting held on 01st & 02nd December 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 14.12.2022. The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dt. 18.01.2023 received on 25.01.2023.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 425th meeting held on 18 May 2023 considered the matter and decided to issue a last reminder (Letter) to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 06.06.2023. The institution has submitted its reply on 07.07.2023.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 427th Meeting held on 20th July, 2023 has considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Kerala University College of Teacher Education, Survey No. 222/2, Kanyamkulam, Government Boys High School, Kanyamkulam Municipality, Alappuzha District, Kerala for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **Kerala University College of Teacher Education, Survey No. 222/2, Kanyamkulam, Government Boys High School, Kanyamkulam Municipality, Alappuzha District, Kerala-690502** for Continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.


14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -



- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
16. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
