WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, Mangalore University, Plot / Khasara No. 572, Plot No. 113, Konaje Village, Mangalagangothri Post, Mangalore Taluk & City, Dakshina Kannada District, Karnataka-574199 vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./KA/2016/85183 dt. 02.05.2016 for conducting B.Ed.-DE course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 500 students from the academic session 2016-2017.

2. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 425th meeting held on 18th May 2023 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice on the following points: -

- Status of Self-Instructional Material and approval from DEB, UGC thereof.*
- Details of the core staff in teacher education working at the University/Distance Education Centre along with their appointment orders.*
- The eligibility criteria adopted by the University/Centre for admissions into the B.Ed. (ODL) programme.*
- Any admission is made without degree/diploma in teacher education through formal system. Details of such admissions.*
- Fee prescribed and projected expenditure details for the programme.*

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.06.2023. The institution has submitted a reply to the Show Cause Notice on 11.07.2023.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before 430th meeting of SRC held on 01st December, 2023 and the SRC decided the following: -

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

After careful perusal of the documents submitted by the institution in response to the SCN & representation received from the institution, the Committee decided to issue the letter of continuation of recognition granted by the NCTE to run the B.Ed. (ODL) programme by Mangalore University, Plot/ Khasara No.572, Plot No.113, Konaje Village, Mangalagangothri Post, Mangalore Taluk & City, Dakshina Kannada District, Karnataka-574199 with an annual intake of 500 students for the purpose of obtaining DEB, UGC approval only.



The University shall ensure the adherence of norms and standards of B.Ed. (ODL) programme particularly the following before the commencement of the academic session, until that admissions should not be made: -

- (i) The approval for Self-Learning Material from the DEB, UGC.*
- (ii) To ensure the availability of core staff at the University/Distance Education Centre.*

In view of the above the SRC directed the Regional Director, SRC to issue the letter of continuation of recognition to the institution with the instruction to comply with the above requirement within 6 months from the issue of the letter and submit compliance report to NCTE."

4. AND WHEREAS, in compliance a letter was issued to the institution on 12.12.2023.

5. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 29.01.2023 which is received in the office of SRC-NCTE on 06.02.2024. The institution has stated as under: -

"We would like to bring to your kind notice that, as per instructions of the Ministry of Higher Education, Govt. of Karnataka, we are not permitted to offer any course including B.Ed. through Distance mode in our University. We have stopped offering all distance education programme including B.Ed. (ODL) since 2020-21. This is for your kind information. Thank you very much for your concerned and cooperation. I kindly request do the needful".

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 433rd Meeting held on 10th February, 2024 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

The institution has submitted reply vide letter dated 29.01.2023 which is received in the office of SRC-NCTE on 06.02.2024. The institution has stated as under: -

"We would like to bring to your kind notice that, as per instructions of the Ministry of Higher Education, Govt. of Karnataka, we are not permitted to offer any course including B.Ed. through Distance mode in our University. We have stopped offering all distance education programme including B.Ed. (ODL) since 2020-21. This is for your kind information. Thank you very much for your concerned and cooperation. I kindly request do the needful".

Hence, the recognition granted to Mangalore University, Plot/Khasara No. 572, Plot No. 113, Konaje Village, Mangalagangothri Post, Mangalore Taluk & City, Dakshina Kannada District, Karnataka-574199 for B.Ed.-ODL programme is withdrawn under



Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993. No fresh admissions are permitted now onwards. However, if any student is pursuing B.Ed.-ODL programme is allowed to continue till they complete the course. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body shall also be withdrawn."

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdrawing the recognition granted to **Mangalore University, Plot/Khasara No. 572, Plot No. 113, Konaje Village, Mangalagangothri Post, Mangalore Taluk & City, Dakshina Kannada District, Karnataka-574199** for conducting **B.Ed.-ODL programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **500 students**. No fresh admissions are permitted now onwards. However, if any student is pursuing **B.Ed.ODL programme** is allowed to continue till, they complete the course. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body shall also be withdrawn.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -


"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. इसके अलावा, संस्था और संबद्ध निकाय को एनसीटीई अधिनियम की धारा 17(4) के निम्नलिखित प्रावधानों के बारे में सूचित किया जाता है: -

"यदि कोई संस्था उप-धारा (1) के तहत मान्यता वापस लेने के आदेश के लागू होने के बाद शिक्षक शिक्षा में कोई पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करती है या जहां कोई संस्थान नियत दिन से ठीक पहले शिक्षक शिक्षा में पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने में विफल रहता है या इस अधिनियम के तहत मान्यता या अनुमति प्राप्त करने हेतु उपेक्षा करता है, तो ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण के अनुसार या ऐसी संस्था में पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण लेने के बाद प्राप्त शिक्षक शिक्षा में योग्यता को केंद्र सरकार, किसी राज्य सरकार या विश्वविद्यालय या केन्द्रीय सरकार या किसी राज्य सरकार द्वारा सहायता प्राप्त किसी स्कूल, कॉलेज या अन्य शैक्षिक संस्था में रोजगार के उद्देश्य के लिए वैध योग्यता के रूप में नहीं माना जाएगा।")

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
