WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Karunya Institute of Technilgy and Sciences (kit), Department of Education, Science & Humanities Block, Karunya University, Karunya Nagar, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641114** run by **Karunya Educational Trust, No. 16, Greenways Road, Chennai, Tamilnadu** vide SRC vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/2009/M.Ed./RO/11977 on 24.04.2009 for conducting (M.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 25 students from the academic session 2009-2010.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 is permitted to vide order F.No. 49-4/2010/PT/NCTE/(N&S) on 30.07.2010 from the session 2010-2011.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution did not submit affidavit for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations and hence, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it is pertinent to mention that the SRC hasn't issued an RPRO (Revised Provisional Recognition Order) to the institution as the institution has not submitted an affidavit, regarding its acceptance for NCTE Regulations, 2014, till date.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted a letter dt. 26.05.2016 alongwith a photocopy of an affidavit. The institution in its letter dt. 26.05.2016 mentioned that "the request from NCTE to submit an affidavit affirming adherence to Regulations 2014 was not responded promptly as the B.Ed. programme was kept in obeyance by the University at that point of time."

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 379th meeting held on 21st & 22nd August 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.09.2019. The institution has not submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 401st meeting held on 11th - 12th August, 2021 considered the non-submission of FSCN reply matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) on 06.09.2019. The institution failed to submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Karunya Institute of Technilgy and Sciences (kit), Department of Education, Science & Humanities Block, Karunya University, Karunya Nagar, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641114** for conducting M.Ed. programme with effect from the academic session i.e.,*

2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.”

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Karunya Institute of Technology and Sciences (KIT), Department of Education, Science & Humanities Block, Karunya University, Karunya Nagar, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641114** for conducting **M.Ed. programme** of two years duration with effect from the academic session i.e., 2021-2022 onwards.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
