ORDER

WHEREAS, University of Hyderabad, Prof. C.R. Rao Road, Central University P.O., Hyderabad – 500 046, Telangana applied for grant of recognition to for offering M.Ed course for two years duration for the academic year 2017-18 under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE through online on 25.05.2016. The institution has submitted the hard copy of the application on 07.06.2016.

2. **AND WHEREAS,** the on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, the SRC in its 332nd meeting held on 28th Feb -3rd March, 2017 decided to issue Letter of Intent (LOI) to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 349th meeting held on 15th & 16th December, 2017 considered the matter and decided as under;

1. **This case has been very badly delayed. The applicant University has not been able to submit the faculty list even after repeated extensions of time-limit.**
2. **Give a final extension upto 20.01.2018.**

4. **AND WHEREAS,** as per decision of SRC a letter was sent on 27.12.2017. The institution submitted its written representation reply on 17.01.2018. The SRC in its 354th meeting held on 18th & 19th January, 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the institution on 09.02.2018. The institution submitted its reply along with faculty list on 27.02.2018. The SRC in its 358th meeting held on 01st – 03rd March, 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC show cause notice was issued on 03.03.2018. The institution submitted its reply on 03.04.2018.

5. **AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 359th meeting held on 17th -18th May, 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue a latter. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Letter was issued on 23.05.2018. **The institution not submitted reply till date.** The SRC in its 370th meeting held on 07th – 8th January, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Rejection order. **Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Rejection order no. F.SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP201630039/M.Ed/KA/2019/101408-410 dated 26.02.2019 was issued to the institution.**

6. **AND WHEREAS,** aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.91-22nd/23rd/24th Mtg./2019-/Appeal/81734 dated 03.09.2019 and the Council remands back the case. The operative part of the Appeal order is as under:-

“AND WHEREASE Smt. G. Bhuvanewara Lakshami, Professor & Head appeared on behalf of appellant university on 02/08/2019 and submitted before Appeal Committee two lists containing the names of one Principal and required

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faculty members duly approved by Registrar of the university. Appeal Committee decided that appellant other required documents as per Terms and Conditions prescribed in the LOI. Appeal Committee further decided to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter in case appellant university submits to them a complete and comprehensive compliance report to the LOI within 15 days to the issue of appeal order.

AND WHEREASE after perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the hearing, Appeal Committee concluded that appellant University should within 15 days of the Appeal order submit to SRC this list alongwith other required documents as per Terms and Conditions prescribed in the LOI. Appeal Committee further decided to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter in case appellant university submits to them a complete and comprehensive compliance report to the LOI within 15 days to the issue of appeal order.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of University of Hyderabad, Gachibowli, Prof, C.R. Rao, Serilingampally, Telangana to the SRC, NCTE for necessary action as indicated above.”

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 considered the and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.09.2019. The institution vide email received dated 13.02.2020 submitted its reply to the show cause notice. The SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th – 13th February, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal reply submitted by the institution on 03.04.2018, the SRC granted recognition/permission to the **University of Hyderabad, Gachibowli Village, Prof. C.R. Rao Road, Serilingampally Mandal, Hyderabad Taluk, Rangareddy District.500046, Telangan for M.Ed. programme** for 1 unit of 50 students from the academic session 2020-21 under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **University of Hyderabad, Prof. C.R. Rao Road, Central University P.O., Hyderabad – 500 046, Telangana** for conducting **M.Ed** for two year duration with an intake of 50 students (one unit) from the academic sessions 2020-2021 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Regulation Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions for M.Ed programme of two year duration:-

(a) The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

(i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.

- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017. which provides as under:-
- **An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.**
 - **All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.**
 - **The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.**
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.

9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt. and also the concerned recognized Institution:-

- (i) **The affiliating body shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliating to the institution.**
- (ii) **The affiliating body shall ensure that the norms including the norms of Faculty for offering M.Ed. component of the programme as per curriculum of these programme in the University, is scrupulously observed.**

10. The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

11. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following:-

- (i) Copy of Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition Order

(v) Information regarding fulfilment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.

12. In case, if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months from the date of recognition order in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the Regional Committee along with new land documents within the stipulated time.

13. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by the MHRD.

14. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order.

15. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

16. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
