#### <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Nagambika College of Education for Women, H.No. 910/39/4/19, Telkar Colony, Kushnoor Road, Gulbarga District- 585106, Karnataka run by Nagambika Educational & Charitable Trust, Gulbarga District, Karnataka vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS05945/B.Ed/2006-2007/15694 dt. 06.12.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 23.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 18.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 317th Meeting held on 28th 30th July, 2016 Meeting of SRC considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 17.09.2016. The institution submitted its reply to the Show Cause Notice vide letter dt.10.10.2016. The institution again submitted reply of the Show Cause Notice on 17.01.2020.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 384the Meeting held on 12th-13th February 2020 considered the matter and decided to constitute VT for shifting of premises of Nagambika College of Education for Women, H.No. 910/39/4/19, Telkar Colony, Kushnoor Road, Gulbarga District- 585106, Karnataka.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, as per the direction of the SRC the inspection was conducted on 11th-12th March 2020 and the VT Report received in this office on 16.03.2020 alongwith land & building documents having address as <a href="Survey No. 126/A">Survey No. 126/A</a>, <a href="Badepur">Badepur</a>, <a href="S.V.P Nagar">S.V.P Nagar</a>, <a href="Behind">Behind</a></a>
  <a href="S.T.B.T New Bus Stand">Stand</a>, <a href="Darga Road</a>, <a href="Gulbarga District-585101">Gulbarga District-585101</a>, <a href="Karnataka">Karnataka</a> and staff list etc.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee considered the Visiting Team Report submitted on 16.03.2020 and decided to **permit for shifting** of the building of the Institution at new premises.

On the perusal of the original documents and records made available in the file. The Committee decided that the continuation orders be issued to Nagambika College of Education for Women, Gulbarga District- 585106, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed course of 2 basic units of 50 students each.

- 7. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Nagambika College of Education to shift its building at new address at Nagambika College of Education, Survey No. 126/A, Badepur, S.V.P Nagar, Behind S.T.B.T New Bus Stand, Darga Road, Gulbarga District-585101, Karnataka run by Nagambika Educational & Charitable Trust, Gulbarga District, Karnataka. Further as per the decision of the SRC, an order for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (two units) of 50 students each subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:
  - I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
- 9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:
  - a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:

- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, guarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities:
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
- 13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
