WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Amar College of Education, Chinabadam Village, Narsipuram Revenue, Palasa Mandal, Tekkali, Srikakulam District-532222, Andhra Pradesh run by Sri Adinarayana Educational Society, Chinnabadam Village and Post, Palasa, Kasibugga Municipality, Palasa Mandal, Srikakulam Dist, Pin-532222, Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.No.APSO7776/B.Ed/AP/2012/45070 dt 09.08.2012 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 22.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 26.06.2020 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 314th meeting held on 27th to 28th May 2016, decided to issue letter. As per the decision of SRC a inspection intimation was send to the institution on 14.06.2016. The institution has submitted written representation through E-mail on 29.06.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 318th meeting held on 8th & 9th August, 2016, decided to issue Show cause notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.09.2016. The institution submitted its written representation along with documents on 18.10.2016. The SRC in its 348th meeting held on 05th 06th December 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. As per decision of SRC, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.12.2017. The institution submitted its written representation along with documents on 09.01.2018. The matter was considered the matter in 360th Meeting of SRC held on 23rd and 24th May 2018 and decided as under:-

1. The agenda is not properly presented.
- 2.1 Decision taken in the last meeting have been presented as deficiencies pointed out.
- 2.2 There is also some discrepancy between the agenda note & MIS printout.
3. The faculty list is not in NCTE Format. Professional course has not been precisely identified.
4. Resubmit Properly.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381th meeting decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a final show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 02.12.2019 submitted its reply to the final show cause notice along with the documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th -13th February 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue last reminder letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a last reminder letter was issued to the institution on 26.02.2020. The institution submitted its reply on 18.03.2020 to the last reminder.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 389th Meeting held on 12th & 14th October, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution on 18.03.2020. The Committee observed and found the following deficiencies:-

1. The institution has not submitted the notarized certified copy of land document.
2. Original copy of staff list approved by the Dean, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University, Srikakulam consisting of one principal, nine assistant professors submitted but the date has not been mentioned. Further, the faculty list is suffering from the following discrepancies :-
 - a) 5 out of 9 professors have been shown appointed after promulgation of NCTE Regulations dated 09.06.2017 and not having NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017. Accordingly they are not qualified to be appointed.
 - b) The approval for nine faculty members has been submitted, which is not sufficient for 100 students (two basic units of B.Ed course). Accordingly, the staff strength found not sufficient as per Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Amar College of Education, Chinabadam Village, Narsipuram Revenue, Palasa Mandal, Tekkali, Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Amar College of Education, Chinabadam Village, Narsipuram Revenue, Palasa Mandal, Tekkali, Srikakulam District-532222, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

"If an Institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution,

shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
