
The intake approved for the academic session 2000-2001 is 40.

The following deficiencies should be set right :

- Four Qualified teacher educators should be appointed so as to maintain the teacher pupil ratio of 1:12 as per Para 2 of NCTE norms.
- Adequate accommodation for common lab should be provided as per Para 3.1.2 of NCTE norms.
- Common rooms should be provided as per Para 3.1.4 of NCTE norms.
- Endowment fund & Reserve fund should be deposited as per Para 5.1 of NCTE norms.

The **Compliance Report** for having set right the above deficiencies should be sent to the Regional Committee not later than 30th June, 2000.
