**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, recognition u/s14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Sri S. Kariappa College of Education, R.E.S. Campus, M.G. Road, kanakapura-562117, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka** vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2005-2006/4947 dt. 24.12.2005 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 10.06.2015. A revised provisional recognition order was issued on 01.07.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the status of issuance of SCN/FSCN was considered by the Sub-Committee constituted by the SRC in its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct., 2019. The Sub-Committee noted that institutions have not submitted requisite documents or only part reply been submitted. The Sub-Committee decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.10.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 406<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Notice was issued to the institution on 03.02.2022. The institution has submitted a reply on 09.03.2022.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 409<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SRC held on 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> March 2022 considered the reply to Final Show Cause Notice and decided as under: -

*"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

*The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 09.03.2022. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.*

1. **The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of Land Title Certificate which is not approved by Competent authority and survey No. and purpose are not mentioned in the document.**

2. **A Notarized copy of Building plan is not approved by the Competent Authority in which survey no., multi-purpose hall area and total built-up area are not mentioned.**
3. **A Notarized copy of Site Plan is not approved by the competent authority.**
4. **The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of BCC is not approved by Competent Authority in which date of inspection, survey no. and multi-purpose Hall area are not mentioned.**
5. **The institute submitted a copy of letter dated 22.02.2022 issued by the Registrar, Bangalore University but principal and 4 Assistant Professors have been approved with the condition to clear NET/SLET within 2/3 years. The conditional approved is not acceptable.**
6. **Lecturers in r/o performing arts/ fine arts and physical education are not appointed by the institution.**
7. **The maturity period of FDRs are less than 05 years.**
8. **The institution did not submit Affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper.**
9. **The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.**

**Hence the recognition granted to Sri S. Kariappa College of Education, R.E.S. Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka-562117 for B.Ed.course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counseling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e., 2022-2023”.**

**6. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition Sri S. Kariappa College of Education, R.E.S. Campus, M.G. Road, Kanakapura, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka-562117 for B.Ed. Course run by The Rural Education Society, Kanakapura, Bangalore Rural District, Karnataka for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate for counselling from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session 2022-2023.**


**7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -**

**“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or**

*permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."*

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
