WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Deccan College of Education, Pamulaparthi Village, Warangal Mandal, Medak District-502779, Andhra Pradesh** vide order no.F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2008-2009/4444 dt.30.08.2008 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008-2009.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated **28.01.2015** and the provisional revised recognition order was issued on 06.05.2015 to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, as per request letter dated 10.12.2015 received from the institution for decrease in intake from 2 to 1 unit for **B.Ed. Programme** an order No. F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS07746/B.Ed./TS/2017-18/94686 dated 06.09.2017 was issued to the institution for reduction of unit from 2 units to 1 unit as per the decision of SRC.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 369th Meeting held on 28.01.2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted requisite documents/VT report accompanied with requisite documents in responds to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.02.2019. The institution has not submitted reply to the Show cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st October & 01st November, 2019 decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT report accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 14.11.2019. The institution has submitted a reply on 30.12.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 409th Meeting of SRC held on 29th – 30th March 2022 considered the matter and decided as under: -

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 30.12.2019. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.



1. **The institution submitted a proforma of 15 faculty for B.Ed. Programme signed by the Registrar, Osmania University but the date of approval is not mentioned, and an approval staff letter issued by Registrar has not submitted.**
2. **Out of 15 faculty, two lecturers namely, Ch. Raju and Ch. Srikanth are not NET/Ph.D. qualified and appointed after 09.06.2017, hence, not eligible for appointment as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 (amended vide notification dated 09.06.2017).**
3. **The institution did not submit Form 'A' issued by the bank for maintenance of FDRs for EF & RF.**
4. **The institution has submitted matured FDRs of Rs. 7 lakhs & 5 Lakhs.**
5. **As per Building Plan, the size of multi-purpose hall is only 141.30 sqm. (15.46*9.14) = (1520.94 sq.ft.) which is less than the requirement laid down under NCTE Regulations, 2014.**
6. **The building plan is not approved by the competent authority and location of building also not mentioned.**
7. **An affidavit in original is not submitted.**
8. **Notarized copy of land documents not submitted. Only Self attested copies submitted.**
9. **The website of the institution is not uploaded with the information required under clauses 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.**
10. **The institution did not submit registration, bye-laws etc. related to the managing society / trust.**
11. **The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty & non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.**

Hence the recognition granted to Deccan College of Education, Pamulaparthi Village, Warangal Mandal, Medak District-502779, Telangana for B.Ed. course is withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the next academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate in counseling / making admissions from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023".

7. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition Deccan College of Education, Pamulaparthi Village, Warangal Mandal, Medak District-502779, Telangana run by Almas Educational Society, Medak District, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) with effect from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023 onwards. Further, on withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body from the academic session stands withdrawn. Hence, the institution is not entitled to participate counselling from the academic session i.e., 2022-2023

and the institution is also not permitted to take any fresh admission of students from the academic session **2022-2023**.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
