CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Rajiv Gandhi Campus, Sringeri, Chikmagalore District, Karnataka-577139** run by **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Sringeri, Chikmagalore District, Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no F.No.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed.-AI/2004-2005/5240 dated 30.01.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students which includes the existing intake of 60 and an additional intake of 40.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st November, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 18.08.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 31.08.2021.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institute namely **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan** had requested for change of name from "**Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan**" to "**Central Sanskrit University**" as the Govt. of India vide notification dt. 22.04.2020 had changed the same.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 402nd Meeting held on 13th & 14th September 2021 has considered the request of the institution vide letter dt. 31.08.2021 and decided to allow the change of name of the institution as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*The committee considered the request made by the institution for change of name of the institution from "**Central Sanskrit University (Deemed University)**" **Rajeev Gandhi Campus, Menase, Bharathi Nagara, Sringeri, Chikmagaluru District, Karnataka-577139**" in light of the **Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020** notified in the **Gazetted of India** on 22.04.2020. The Committee also decided that continuation order be issued to the Institution for **B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students**.*

The Committee further directed to change in the records and website accordingly."

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, permission of SRC to the institution for change of name of the institution from **“Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Deemed University)” Rajeev Gandhi Campus, Sringeri, Karnataka** to **“Central Sanskrit University (Deemed University)” Rajeev Gandhi Campus, Menase, Bharathi Nagara, Sringeri, Chikkmagaluru District, Karnataka-577139** in light of clause 59(5) of Karnataka State Universities’ Act, 2000, along with Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two-year duration with annual intake of **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

6. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.

- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

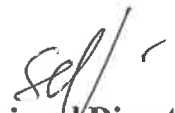
