**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Pragathi College of Education, Rangareddy DT, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.AP/NEW/B.Ed/284/SRO/NCTE/2002-2003/6688 dt 8.4.2003 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 21.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic unit) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted its written representation on 31.10.2015 along with some relevant documents. The documents were processed and placed before SRC In its 315<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 decided to constitute VT. The Inspection of the institution was conducted on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup> November 2016 and VT report along with documents and CD received on 09.11.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 339<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2017 considered the VT report and decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC show cause notice was sent to the institution on 30.05.2017.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted reply along with documents on 28.06.2017. The SRC in its 344<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> August 2017 considered the matter and decided as under;

1. The issue relating to change of Management has been satisfactorily explained. It is a case of only a change in the name of the Management and not the Management itself. We accept this explanation.
2. They have shifted without permission. We have to consider this.
3. Process the documents collected and report.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 346<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> October 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was sent to the institution on 02.11.2017. The SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 01<sup>st</sup> Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issued SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 19.11.2019. The institutions vide letter dated 05.12.2019 submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue withdrawal order. Accordingly, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide order no. F/SRO/NCTE/APSO0324/B.Ed/AP/2020/117865 dt.

08.09.2020. aggrieved by the order of the SRC the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order dated 07.12.2020 appeal remand back the Order appealed against. The institution vide letter dated 08.12.2020 submitted reply to the alongwith land & building documents having address as Sy.No. 1140, Near Adjacent to NTPC Road, Ghanapur (V), Ghatkesar (M), Medchal-Malakajgiri District- 501301, Telangana and staff list etc.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Pragathi College of Education, Hyderabad East Revenue Division, 1-53, Peerzadiguda Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, Rangareddy District, Telangana for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Pragathi College of Education, Sy.No. 1140, Near Adjacent to NTPC Road, Ghanapur (V), Ghatkesar (M), Medchal-Malakajgiri District- 501301, Telangana run by Kommuri Pratap Reddy Education Society, F.No. 207, Sai Pragathi Towers, Himayathnagar ain Road, Hyderabad-29, Telangana for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (2 basic units) of subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

I.The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

II.The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

III.The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

IV.The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

10. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
