WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Andhra Muslim College of Education, D.No.17-11-24, Ponnur Road, Guntur-522003, Andhra Pradesh** run by **Mohammadiya Education Society, Guntur-522003, Andhra Pradesh** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. **F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2007-2008/8724** dt 23.08.2007 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

**AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt. 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

**AND WHEREAS**, a revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

**AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 21.02.2019. The institution has submitted a letter dated 28.02.2019 in response to the Show Cause Notice

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issued Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.10.2020. The institution vide letter dated 06.11.2020 submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

**AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:- The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution in respect of Final Show Cause Notice issued on 21.10.2020. The Committee observed the following deficiencies: -

1. The institution has not submitted certified copy of land document.
  2. The institution has submitted building plan but not readable and not legible.
  3. The institution has not submitted the "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years along with a copy of the FDRs
  4. The institution has submitted a faculty list which is not approved by the Affiliating body.
- Some deficiencies are: -

- (a) Five Lecturers does not have NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017.
5. A letter regarding approval of faculty issued by the affiliating body has not submitted by the institution.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Andhra Muslim College of Education, D.No.17-11-24, Ponnur Road, Guntur-522003, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed, courses w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of Andhra Muslim College of Education, D.No.17-11-24, Ponnur Road, Guntur-522003, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) w.e.f. the next academic session.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

**"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."**

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
