**ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Sri Chakra College Education Sy. no. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimpatnam Mandal, H.D.M. A. Rangareddy, Andhra Pradesh run by Srinivasa Educational Society, Sy. No. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimpatnam Mandal, H.M.D.A. Rangareddy District, Pin-501510 Andhra Pradesh vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.No.APSO8574/B.Ed/AP/2012/45744 dt. 03.09.2012 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2012-2013.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter dated 08.04.2014 was received from the Principal, Sri Chakra College of Education, Sheriguda, IBPTM, Rangareddy District, HMDA, Andhra Pradesh on 07.05.2014. The SRC in its 269<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 1-2 July, 2014 considered the reply and other relevant document and decided to issue show cause. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 07.08.2014. The institution submitted reply on 27.08.2014. The SRC in its 273<sup>rd</sup> meeting held during 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 considered the reply along with relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdrawal order.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of SRC, withdrawal order issued to the institution on 19.11.2014. Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs. NCTE, Hqrs. vide order. F.No. 89-02/2015 Appeal/2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting -2015 dated 05.05.2015.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter dated 21.04.2015 and 15.05.2015 received by this office from the Principal. The SRC in its 287<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2016, considered the appeal remand back case and decided to "Restore Recognition." Accordingly, Restored Recognition order was issued on 29.05.2015. The institution submitted its written representation along with relevant documents on 05.11.2015. The SRC its 314<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 the committee decided to issue intimation letter.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, inspection intimation was sent to the institution on 14.06.2015. Inspection of the institution was conducted on 09.10.2016 & 10.10.2016 and VT report along with documents and CD received on 13.10.2016. The SRC in its 323<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 considered the VT report and decided to issue show cause notice to issues show cause notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.11.2016. The institution did not reply to the show cause notice till date.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the Sub-committee constituted by the SRC as per decision taken in its 380<sup>th</sup> meeting. The Sub-committee of the SRC decided to issued Final Show Cause Notice. to all such institution where reply to SCN has not been

submitted by the institution. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to institution on 11.10.2019. The institution did not submit reply to the Final Show Cause Notice till date. The SRC in its 382<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue withdrawal order. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO8574/B.Ed/AP/2019/112928-2934 dated 10.12.2019 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.91-8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup>Mtg./2020-Appeal/91558 dated 23.07.2020 and the Council remands back the case. The SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020 has considered the matter and the Committee decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice on 07.09.2020. The institution vide letter dated 24.11.2020 submitted reply to the alongwith land & building documents having address as Sy.No. 209, Bagayath Ibrahimpatnam, Sheriguda (Vill & Grampanchayat), Ibrahimpatnam (M), R.R. District- 501510, Telangana and staff list etc.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Sri Chakra College Education Sy. no. 209, Sheriguda Village, Ibrahimpatnam Mandal, H.D.M. A. Rangareddy, Telangana.** for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Sri Chakra College Education, Sy.No. 209, Bagayath Ibrahimpatnam, Sheriguda (Vill & Grampanchayat), Ibrahimpatnam (M), R.R. District- 501510, Telangana run by Srinivasa Education Society, Plot No. 12 Part & 13, Gandhi Nagar, Vanasthalipuram, Hyderabad-70, Telangana for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (2 basic units) of subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

I.The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

II.The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

10. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

12. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

14. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

15. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself

vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
