WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Bhashyam College of Education, Mallikharjunapuram Colony, Gorantla Village, Guntur-522034, Andhra Pradesh run by Bhashyam Educational Society, Guntur-522007, Andhra Pradesh. The SRC vide order F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2007-2008/12334 dt.01.10.2007 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2007-08 with an annual intake of 100 students.

- AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 20.02.2015. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 363rd meeting held on 17th to 19th September 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 12.10.2018. The institution vide letter dated 28.11.2018 submitted its reply to the show cause notice.
- AND WHEREAS, the Sub-Committee of the SRC in 381st meeting decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to all such institution where reply to Show Cause Notice has not been submitted by the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated nil received on 13.08.2020 submitted its reply to the final show cause notice.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392nd meeting held on December 15-16, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution in respect of Final Show Cause Notice issued on 13.11.2019. The Committee observed the following deficiencies: -

- 1. The Institution has submitted photocopy of land document, certified copy of land documents not submitted
- 2. The extent of land converted is not mentioned in the land use certificate
- 3. The Building plan submitted is in the name of an individual.
- The institution has not submitted certified copy of site plan.
 The survey no. mentioned in BCC is 150/B & 118/1 whereas in the land document, the survey no. mentioned are 392/2 &118/1. The institution is required to clarify the difference in the survey nos. The BCC submitted is not in the format as prescribed by the NCTE
- 6. The proforma of the faculty submitted by the institution which signed by the Registrar, Nagarjuna University, but the date of the approval is not mentioned over it.
- 7. Photocopy of staff list approved by the Registrar, Acharya Nagarjuna University consisting of one principal, 14 assistant professors submitted dated NIL for the academic session 2018-19
- 8. The 5 Lecturers have been shown appointed on 18.10.2017, 04.05.2018, 29.07.2017, 18.10.2017, 18.05.2018, thus not having NET/Ph.D. as per NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.05.2017 notified on 09.06.2017. Other staff have been shown appointed before promulgation of NCTE Regulations dated 09.06.2017.
 - Faculty in respect of Fine arts is not appointed. (a)
 - The institution has also submitted photocopy of staff list of (b) D.Ed. Course (1+7) approved by Director, SCERT dated NIL for the year 2013.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Bhashyam College of Education, Mallikharjunapuram Colony, Gorantia Village, Guntur-522034, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed, courses w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

- NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to Bhashyam College of Education, Mallikharjunapuram Colony, Gorantla Village, Guntur-522034, Andhra Pradesh run by Bhashyam Educational Society, Guntur-522007, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.
- Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
