WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Holy Crescent College of Education, Thaikattukara P.O. Alwaye-683106, Ernakulam District, Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.KL/SEC/N/186/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/760 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting **B.Ed. course** of one-year duration with an annual intake of **100 students** from the academic session **2004-2005**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated **21.01.2015** for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on **15.05.2015** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter dated 10.06.2015 was received from the institution for requesting an annual intake of **one basic unit of 50 students**. Accordingly, a Corrigendum was issued to the institution vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00505/ B.Ed./KL/2015/68465 on 26.06.2015.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the request of the institution was placed before SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted by the institution. Accordingly, **First Show Cause Notice** issued on 17.07.2019. and the institution has not submitted any compliance.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the request of the institution was placed before SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18-19 September 2019. The committee considered the matter and decided to Final Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution. Accordingly, a **Final Show Cause Notice** issued to the institution on **31.10.2019** and the institution has not submitted any compliance.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389th meeting held on October 12th & 14th, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: --

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 31.10.2019.

- 1. The institution has not submitted any reply / written representation in response to the Final Show Cause Notice issued on 31.10.2019.**

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Holy Crescent College of Education, Thaikkattukara P.O. Alwaye-683106, Ernakulam District, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

8. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Holy Crescent College of Education, Thaikkattukara P.O. Alwaye-683106, Ernakulam District, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100** students w.e.f. the next academic session.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
