WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Iqbal Training College, Daivapura P.O. Peringammala, Thiruvananthapuram District, Pin-695563, Kerala. vide SRC (NCTE) order No F. KL/SEC/N/192/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/910 dated 25.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated 09.02.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

3. AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

5. AND WHEREAS, accordingly, First Show Cause Notice issued on 04.09.2019 to reply within 30 days. The institution submitted its reply vide dated 30.10.2019 and reply received on 06.11.2019.

6. AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 383st meeting held on 07th & 09th January 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue a Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993.

7. AND WHEREAS, accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice issued on 24.01.2019 to reply within 21 days. The institution submitted its reply vide dated 07.02.2019 and reply received on 13.02.2019.

8. AND WHEREAS, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 387th meeting held on August 24th & 25th, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:- On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution on 13.02.2020. The Committee observed and found the following deficiencies: -

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1. The LUC submitted by the institution do not show the purpose of Land for educational purpose.
2. The institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan instead of Original Blue-Prints. The Built Up area is not adequate as per Building Plan for 2 basic units of B.Ed programme.
3. The Site Plan submitted by the institution which is not approved by the competent authority.
4. The institution has submitted staff list which is not approved by the Registrar, affiliating university.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Iqbal Training College, Daivapura P.O. Peringammala, Thiruvananthapuram District, Pin – 695563, Kerala for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

09. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, Withdrawal order issued on 07.09.2019.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, The order dt. 25.09.2020 issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam in W.P. No. 18749/2020.

" The petitioner institution in the respective writ petitions shall submit the list of faculties in the prescribed format, before the affiliating University, within one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgement, if not already submitted. The affiliating University shall permit admission for B.Ed. Course in the petitioner institutions, for the academic session year 2020-21, only if the faculties are having the requisite qualification as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014. The faculties appointed after 09.06.2017 shall have the requisite qualification as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, as amended by the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) (Amendment) Regulation, 2017. No order as to costs."

11. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389th Meeting held on 12th & 14 October 2020 and the Committee decided that: -

The SRC noted the Order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam in W.P.(C) No. 18243/2020 (E) and other connected WPs and decided that the following institutions be directed to submit the list of faculty members (in prescribed format) duly approved by the affiliating body within one week along with the other documents mentioned under withdrawal order of concerned institution. Further, the SRC also resolved to inform the following institutions with an endorsement to the University that until the Revised Recognition Order is issued by the NCTE, the institution should not make any admissions as desired by the Hon'ble High Court.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, letter issued on 19.10.2020. The institution submitted its reply vide date 10.10.2020 and reply received on 14.10.2020.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 391th Meeting held on 03rd November 2020 and the Committee decided that: -

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, documents furnished by the institution and the order issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

In compliance of the directions delivered by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, opportunity for personal hearing was provided to the institution. The personal hearing before the Southern Regional Committee was held on 29.10.2020. The case of the institution was presented by **Dr. B.Sarin, Principal**.

The Committee after going through the presentation of the institution and careful consideration of documents presented by the institution vide its letter dt. 14.10.2020 & email 29.10.2020 observed the following:-

1. The Committee observed that the institution during personal hearing agreed that the grounds of withdrawal of recognition was valid as they had failed in submission of reply.
2. The Committee considered the presentation of the institution that they had now submitted its reply alongwith faculty list approved by the affiliating body after the issuance of withdrawal order of recognition and on the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.
3. The Committee considered the requests of the institution for re-consideration on the basis of directions of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala and the institution desires to run the institution with an annual intake of 50 (One Unit) only from now onwards.

The following has been decided by the Committee :-

1. The institution in its representation submitted the list of faculty submitted by the University for approval but the Committee observed that the institution had failed in submission of approval of the affiliating University even after the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.

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Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Iqbal Training College, Daivapura P.O. Peringammala, Thiruvananthapuram District, Pin-695563, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed** course w.e.f. the 2020-2021 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

13. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Iqbal Training College, Daivapura P.O. Peringammala, Thiruvananthapuram District, Pin – 695563, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

14. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

15. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
