WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Alathur Post, Palakkad District, Pin – 678541, Kerala. vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.KL/SEC/N/136/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/757 dated 23.02.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated 30.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations.
3. AND WHEREAS, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 13.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.
4. AND WHEREAS, A photocopy of letter No.22569/CDC-A2/2014/CU dated 16.11.2015 was received from University of Calicut approved by the Deputy Registrar regarding Redistribution of seats in optional subjects with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic year 2015-16 onwards.
5. AND WHEREAS, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 343rd meeting held on August 1-2, 2017 and the Committee decided to reduction of intake strength from 100 student (two unit) to 50 student (one basic unit).
6. AND WHEREAS, Accordingly, an order for reduction of strength from 2 units to 1 unit issued to the institution vide No. F.No. SRO/NCTE/APSO0714/B.Ed./KL/2017-18/94879 on 13.09.2017.
7. AND WHEREAS, The matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.
8. AND WHEREAS, Accordingly, First Show Cause Notice issued on 16.07.2019 to the reply within 30 days. The institution submitted its reply on 29.08.2019.
9. AND WHEREAS, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on January 7-9, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice.
10. AND WHEREAS, accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 20.01.2020. The institution submitted its reply on 29.01.2020 & 04.02.2020.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 387th meeting held on August 24th & 25th 2020 and the Committee decided that "Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to **B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Alathur Post, Palakkad District, Pin – 678541, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, The Withdrawal Order issued to the institution on 07.09.2020.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed W.P. (C) 18243 of 2020 (E). In the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam against withdrawal order dt. 07.09.2020. The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala passed an order dt. September 25, 2020.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 389th Meeting held on 12th&14 October 2020 and the Committee decided that: -

"The SRC noted the Order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam in W.P.(C) No. 18243/2020 (E) and other connected WPs and decided that the following institutions be directed to submit the list of faculty members (in prescribed format) duly approved by the affiliating body within one week along with the other documents mentioned under withdrawal order of concerned institution. Further, the SRC also resolved to inform the following institutions with an endorsement to the University that until the Revised Recognition Order is issued by the NCTE, the institution should not make any admissions as desired by the Hon'ble High Court"

15. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, The letter was issued to the institution on 16.10.2020, an E-mail reply received dated 14.10.2020 and reply was received on 20.10.2020.

16. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 391th Meeting held on 03rd November 2020 and the Committee decided that:

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, documents furnished by the institution and the order issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

In compliance of the directions delivered by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, opportunity for personal hearing was provided to the institution. The personal hearing before the Southern Regional Committee was held on 29.10.2020. The case of the institution was presented by **Dr. Balambika K.S., Principal**.

The Committee after going through the presentation of the institution and careful consideration of documents presented by the institution vide its letter dt 20.10.2020 & 14.10.2020 and email dt 29.10.2020 and observed the following:-

1. The Committee observed that the institution during personal hearing agreed that the grounds of withdrawal of recognition was valid as they had failed in submission of reply.
2. The Committee considered the presentation of the institution that they had now submitted its reply alongwith faculty list approved by the affiliating body after the issuance of withdrawal order of recognition and on the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.
3. The Committee considered the requests of the institution for re-consideration on the basis of directions of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala and the institution desires to run the institution with an annual intake of 50 (One Unit) only from now onwards.

The following has been decided by the Committee:-

The Committee is dissatisfied with the documents submitted by the institution and oral arguments that the institution has failed in submission of the following even after the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala :-

1. A photocopy of Staff List approved by Registrar; University of Calicut submitted vide dated 03.09.2020 consisting of one principal & Seven Assistant Professor against the requirement of 1+9=10 faculty stipulated under Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
2. Percentage of marks in r/o Lecturer English, namely "Smt. Meera TN" in Education at (S.No.03) is 51.88% which less than 55% in post-graduation.
3. Percentage of marks in r/o Lecturer English, namely "Smt. Jini M George" in Education at (S.No.06) is 50% less than 55% in post-graduation.
4. Three are part time lecturers appointed against full time faculty are as following:-
 - Ms. Sruthi S (Asst. Prof.) -Part Time.
 - Mr.Santhosh V (Assistant Prof.) -Part Time.
 - Mr. Sangardas PH (Assistant Prof. in music) -Part Time.
5. The institution submitted a photocopy of the building plan but the same is not readable, hence, the Committee was unable to analyse the size of class rooms, M.P.Hall, Labs, Library etc. as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Alathur Post, Palakkad District, Pin-678541, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed course w.e.f. the next academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

16. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdrawal recognition granted to **B.S.S. B.Ed. Training College, Alathur Post, Palakkad District, Pin – 678541, Kerala** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

17. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

18. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
