**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely Chinmay Chandramati College of Education, Survey No. 337, Near Bridge, Devara Konda, Main Road, Nalgonda District - 81, Telangana run by The Mahalakshmi Devi Education Society, Rahagundry, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh. The SRC vide order F.SRO/APS04253/B.Ed./2004-2005/572 dt.05.07.2005 for conducting (B.Ed.) course of two-year duration from the academic session 2004-05 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 27.01.2015. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 11.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its written representation on 31.10.2015 along with relevant documents. The SRC in its 315<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> June 2016 considered the matter and decided as under:-

1. The recognition in this case was given to Mahalakshmi Devi Educational Society.
2. But, all documents now presented are in the name of Zarine Educational Society.
3. Ask them to explain this discrepancy before we can take up the shifting matter.
4. They must make a separate application for change in the name of the Society, fulfill the formalities prescribed for such cases and, only thereafter, move for further action for shifting.

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the Institution on 13.07.2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the Southern Regional Committee-in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019. The Committee decided to issue show cause notice to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance of the revised recognition order. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the Institution on 21.02.2019. The Institution vide letter dated 24.04.2019 submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 01<sup>st</sup> Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issued FSCN in all such matters where the Institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 25.11.2019. The Institution vide letter dated 20.12.2019 submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on December 15-16, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows: -

The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

1. At the time of recognition on 05.07.2005, the managing society was Mahalakshmi Devi Educational Society and different / another society namely Zarine Educational Society is shown while submission of reply of Final Show Cause Notice. The SRC observed the clear change in management which is not permissible under NCTE Act, rules and Regulations, 2014.
2. The Building Plan submitted by the institution is not legible.
3. The proforma of the staff submitted by the institution signed by the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University but the Date of the Approval is not mentioned over it.
4. Six faculty namely N. Spandana, G. Saidulu, B. Saidhaiha, K. Venkat Reddy, G. Ganapathi and Anitha.M (6 faculty) have joined / appointed after 09.06.2017 do not possess the NET qualification, hence, are not qualified as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 (Amended vide its notification dated 09.06.2017 of NCTE).

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Chinmay Chandramati College of Education, Survey No. 337, Near Bridge, Devara Konda, Main Road, Nalgonda District – 81, Telangana** for conducting B.Ed, courses w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to **Chinmay Chandramati College of Education, Survey No. 337, Near Bridge, Devara Konda, Main Road, Nalgonda District – 81, Telangana** run **The Mahalakshmi Devi Education Society, Rahagundry, East Godavari, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students w.e.f. the next academic session.

8. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

**“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or**

University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
